The Maryland Community Health System supports *Senate Bill 411 – Health Insurance – Postpartum Depression Screening – Required Coverage and Authorized Cost Sharing*. The bill would require state-regulated private plans to cover postpartum depression screening.

Maryland Community Health System is a network of federally qualified health centers providing primary, behavioral, and dental care to underserved communities throughout Maryland. Postpartum depression has a significant impact on the health of both mother and newborn. With our Medicaid patients, the State is undergoing a systems transformation to screen and identify risks, including postpartum depression, for new moms as a result of House Bill 1051/Senate Bill 1059 last year. This year, SB 411 would help close the gap for individuals with coverage of postpartum services from private insurance.
