Written Testimony in SUPPORT of SB 17

Madam Chair and members of the Finance Committee, I am here to introduce and voice my support for Senate Bill 17 – *Anne Arundel County - Alcoholic Beverages Licenses - Veterans' Organizations*.

SB 17 would authorize a certain holder of a Class C beer, wine, and liquor license in Anne Arundel County to convert the license to a Class C (veterans' organization) license, reducing the annual license fee from \$400 to \$300 for a Class C (veterans' organization) license. It would also authorize the Board of License Commissioners for Anne Arundel County to provide application and administrative fee discounts to certain licensees and applicants and authorize a Class C (veterans' organization) licensee to operate on Sunday without a Sunday license.
