HB0895/SB0279 Employment and Insurance Equality for Service Members Act January 10, 2025

The Maryland Joint Veterans Committee (JVC) **SUPPORTS** HB0895/SB0279 Employment and Insurance Equality for Service Members Act for the following reasons:

- This bill updates and standardizes terms across the law.
- The bill adds all Uniformed Service Members, not just the Armed Forces.
- Adds Eligible Spouses
- Changes to Reserve Component from National Guard.
- Recognizes Uniformed Services Training and Education.
- Allows for temporary licensing for Active Service Members, Eligible Veterans, and Eligible Spouses when moving from out of state.

The JVC encourages a **FAVORABLE** vote.
