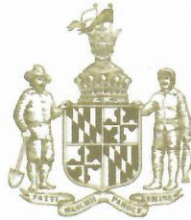

AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 1174
(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, strike beginning with "specifying" in line 6 down through "consumption;" in line 8.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, in line 17, strike "(1)"; in line 18, strike the brackets; in the same line, strike "(I)"; in line 20, strike the first set of brackets; in the same line, strike "(II)"; and strike in their entirety lines 22 through 29, inclusive.

EXPLANATION OF THE AMENDMENTS:

AMENDMENT NO. 1:

Makes a technical change to the title of the bill.

AMENDMENT NO. 2:

Strikes the proposed requirement that a holder of a second Class BD-BWL alcoholic beverages license be limited to providing only private-label alcoholic beverage products manufactured exclusively for the holder for off-premises consumption and restores the requirement from current law that any holder of a Class BD-BWL license may provide beer and for on or off-premises consumption and liquor only for on-premises consumption.
