The Maryland Association of Counties (MACo) **SUPPORTS** HB 235. This bill strengthens local government cybersecurity by providing critical resources and collaboration tools for conducting vulnerability and cyber assessments. HB 235 directly addresses this need by ensuring local governments can access the necessary resources and guidance to assess vulnerabilities and enhance their cybersecurity posture.

By providing structured support for cybersecurity assessments, HB 235 enables counties to take proactive measures to protect critical systems and services.
