The Maryland Department of Disabilities (MDOD) is pleased to submit this letter of support for HB 455 - Braille Flag Memorial Act of 2025. This bill authorizes the Department of Veterans and Military Families to designate a location to install the American Braille Tactile flag at Maryland's veterans' cemeteries.

Maryland represents a nexus of employment, transportation, and housing opportunities for the 116,000 blind and low vision individuals who live here. Maryland is also home to military installations, blindness advocacy organizations, and veterans who served with distinction.
