Re: HB 849 - Maryland Commission to Study the Dental Hygienist Shortage-Dental Board-Support with Amendment

Dear Chair Peña-Melnyk and Members of the Health and Government Operations Committee:

The Maryland State Board of Dental Examiners respectfully submits this support with amendment position paper for HB 849-Maryland Commission to Study the Dental Hygienist Shortage. The bill establishes a Commission to assess the dental hygienist shortage in the State and make recommendations regarding methods to improve the recruitment and retention of dental hygienists in public and private settings; expand dental hygiene education opportunities at institutions of higher learning; increase retention of dental hygiene students through educational support and wraparound services; and supporting dental assistants and community health workers in accessing dental hygiene educational opportunities. The Commission is charged with submitting an interim report on or before December 1, 2025, and a final report on or before December 1, 2026.

The Board supports the establishment of the Commission but believes that the Commission should include a dental hygienist member of the Dental Board since the Board's dental hygienist members possess first-hand knowledge and experience in the field, and related dental hygiene issues and obstacles that arose during the COVID-19 pandemic.

Therefore, the Dental Board offers the following amendment:
On page 2, in line 25 strike "and"; in line 26 strike "." and substitute ";" and add
(VII) ONE DENTAL HYGIENIST REPRESENTATIVE FROM THE MARYLAND DENTAL BOARD.

For the foregoing reasons, the Board requests that the Committee adopt the Board's amendment.
