Bill: House Bill 1399 – Health Occupations – Cross-Sex Hormone Therapy for

Minors – Prohibition Act

Hearing Date: March 11, 2025

Position: Oppose

The Maryland Affiliate of the American College of Nurse Midwives (ACNM) strongly opposes *House Bill 1399 – Health Occupations – Cross-Sex Hormone Therapy for Minors – Prohibition Act.* Under the bill, healthcare practitioners could receive a felony conviction and up to lifetime imprisonment for prescribing, administering, or dispensing hormones to treat gender dysphoria for minors. This legislation would cost lives. Gender-affirming care is lifesaving for adolescents and safeguards their health and wellbeing.¹ This legislation would have a chilling effect on the provision of any hormonal treatment for minors or adults, just as abortion bans have impeded the provision of miscarriage care even in emergencies.
