## MARYLAND DEPARTMENT OF LABOR LETTER OF INFORMATION ON HB 509.

BILL: HB 509 Maryland Inventory of Cemeteries and Burial Sites Workgroup -

Establishment

House Bill 509 establishes a workgroup between the Office of Cemetery Oversight ("OCO") and the Maryland Historical Trust for the purpose of studying issues related to the creation and maintenance of a State cemetery inventory system. This workgroup will also explore various laws and regulations pertaining to cemeteries and burial sites and evaluate the feasibility and cost of establishing a grant program to provide financial assistance to governmental entities and nonprofit genealogical and historical organizations.

The OCO is a small self-funded unit. When fully staffed, the OCO consists of a total of three full-time employees and one part-time employee. Due to OCO's limited staffing, the OCO will have to increase staff to handle the new duties created by House Bill 509. Furthermore, since the OCO is a self-funded unit, it will be challenging for the OCO to absorb the additional staffing and legal expenses that will be necessary to fulfill the goals of this workgroup.
