Our district would love to be able to purchase local produce, but do not have the time or staffing to write out a bid, ensure that we are reaching all the local certified farms and then arrange the logistics for deliveries to all our schools.

HB56 will allow MSDE to write the contracts for purchasing local food products at no cost to the state of Maryland and this will save our district both time and money. I encourage you to support local school districts by supporting HB 56. This legislation will be beneficial to so many local school districts.

In addition to staffing and budget constraints as already mentioned, I have highlighted for you below a few additional benefits of supporting this legislation:

- This will ensure purchasing foods grown at Certified Local Farms
- USDA will reach out to farmers and distributors to encourage them to list their products on the bid making more products available to schools
