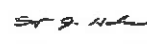

On 06/09/2022 I responded to the area of Bikle Rd immediately after leaving traffic court. Upon arrival I was contacted by Sgt. Kemmerer and instructed to respond to the Smithsburg Valley Church at [redacted]. At the church I made contact Holly, the daycare program leader. At this time it was decided that phone calls would be made to all of the parents of children in attendance. As the parents were called and subsequently arrived the children were released from the building and escorted to their parents by myself, M/Dep Snodderly or M/Dep Palladino.

Once all of the children were removed from the daycare center within the church, I responded to Bikle Rd at the entrance of the church to maintain the scene security and keep the media/ on lookers at a distance. During this time I was asked to clear my location and check a local orchard as well as fields in the area as suspicious persons were observed in those locations. These persons were found to be media and local residents. I remained in this position, on the perimeter until I secured at approximately 2030hrs.

On June 9, 2022 at approximately 1450 hrs, DFC. Lam responded to in reference to an active shooter. Upon DFC. Lam's arrival, at approximately 1508 hrs, numerous law enforcement officers from the Smithsburg Police Department, Washington County Sheriff's office, and Maryland State Police along with Emergency Medical Technicians (EMT) and paramedics had already arrived on scene. A broad perimeter was established from the telephone poles on the west side of the building to the exterior of the field on the northwest corner of the property. DFC. Lam maintained the crime scene log to the best of his abilities as the scene was fluid and rapidly evolving. Personnel from the Hagerstown Police Department (HPD), Federal Bureau of Investigations(FBI), and The Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms, and Explosives (ATF) later arrived on scene to assist with the investigation.

As more information was gathered, the crime scene perimeter was scaled down to the fenced in area of the property. Not all personnel initially documented on the crime scene log actually entered the fence line or building. At approximately 2000 hrs, DFC. Fazenbaker took over the Crime Scene log for DFC. Lam.

It should be noted "PTA" on the crime scene log stand for Prior to Arrival (DFC. Lam's arrival). Due to the rapidly evolving complexity of this incident and high volume of radio traffic, it is extremely difficult to determine the exact times of everyone's arrival. DFC. Lam was not marked on scene or placed on the call until 1553 after he requested dispatch for the second time to do so.

This case is being handled by the Washington County Sheriff's Office Criminal Investigations Unit .

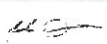
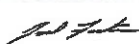

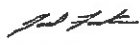

On Thursday, June 9th, 2022, Deputy Buskirk of the Washington County Sheriff's Office responded to for a report of an active shooter incident.

When Deputy Buskirk arrived on scene, Sgt Kemmerer of the Sheriff's Department had assumed command. Sgt Kemmerer tasked Deputy Buskirk to the rear of the building to stand post and assist with securing the perimeter of the building. Deputy Buskirk stood post on perimeter for several hours and the only human contact was with neighbors and a reporter. These contacts were brief and consisted of keeping them outside of the perimeter of the building. It should be noted that there was a security fence with barbed wire at the top separating Deputy Buskirk from the

Deputy Buskirk stood post on the perimeter until approximately 2130 hrs. Assisting on the rear perimeter with Deputy Buskirk was Trooper Buzzard of the Maryland State Police. Looking directly at the rear of the building, Deputy Buskirk secured the left side of the building perimeter which was closest to Jefferson Boulevard. Trooper Buzzard secured the right of the rear perimeter of the building.

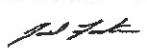

On Friday 6-10-2022 at approximately 1436 hrs. I responded to the area of Smithsburg, Washington County, Maryland to assist in locating the suspect/vehicle involved in a shooting that took place in the Bikle Rd. Area. While responding, I diverted to travel south on Maryland Rt. 66/Mapleville Rd. Upon my arrival in the area of Mt. Aetna Rd. And Maryland Rt. 66 (roundabout) traffic was stopped on the right side of the roundabout, so I proceeded to the left side of the roundabout to continue traveling south. At that time I witnessed a blue unmarked police vehicle and a maroon unmarked suv along with an orange passenger car stopped on the south side of the roundabout. As I began to exit my patrol vehicle, I heard sounds of gunfire, and witnessed a male who had exited the unmarked vehicle standing in the area of the drivers side of the , with a weapon in his hand. Once the gunfire had ended, I began to move towards the incident scene as numerous other police agencies and officers began to arrive. Those arriving officers began to administer first aid to the officer and suspect who apparently were wounded during the shots fired incident. The only enforcement action that I took at that time was to secure the left side of the scene and maintain security of same. Once that part of my actions were completed, I left the scene and traveled to the original shooting scene on Bikle Rd. To assist if needed there. No further information to be provided.

Action Taken:

On Thursday, June 9, 2022, Officer Jerry Morales of the Smithburg Police Department responded to Columbia Machine Inc., located at the address for a report of an active shooter.

At approximately 2:38 PM, Officer Morales arrived and observed no activity at this location. Officer Morales then observed three subjects in a field between the business and Bikle Road.

One subject, later identified as Brandon Chase Michael, a with the was lying upon the ground face up with two other males who were attending to him. Officer Morales approached the subjects and asked, "shooter?!" and was informed Brandon was a victim of a gunshot wound.

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Officer Morales observed gunshots to Brandon's
Officer Morales placed a tourniquet to Brandon's high on the shoulder and another
off-duty civilian/EMT applied his tourniquet to Brandon's Brandon was
eventually transported to Meritus Medical Center to be treated for his wounds.

Chief Robert Marker, of the Smithsburg Police Department, arrived at Columbia Machine Inc., along with Officer Morales. Chief Marker observed Officer Morales tending to a victim in the field outside of the building. That victim was identified as Brandon Michael. Chief Marker then observed a male walking from the entrance of the building towards Officer Morales.

Chief Marker contacted the approaching male, identified later as Tom Andrew Neil, who is the General Manager of Columbia Machine Inc. Tom told Chief Marker that there were three victims inside the building in the break room. Chief Marker asked Tom if the suspect was in the area still, and Tom advised that the suspect had fled in an with damage to the passenger side of the vehicle.

Chief Marker entered the building and contacted a female at the front desk. That female was later identified as Dawn Marie Greene,
. Chief Marker continued through the building and entered the shop area where he observed two deceased males lying on the floor near an interior room inside of the shop area. Chief Marker looked into the interior room, which was determined to be a break room, and observed third male subject that was obviously deceased lying in the floor in the break room.

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Chief Marker met with Tom, the General Manager, in the front office area and requested full information of the suspect and the victims. Tom was able to print off the suspects information, however he was not able to obtain the victims information due to a computer issue. Deputy Javier Montenegro contacted Chief Marker and inquired if all of the employees were accounted for. Tom told Chief Marker that an employee named "Hunter" was unaccounted for at that time. Chief Marker looked through the building for "Hunter", eventually locating "Hunter" hiding behind a green roll off canister. Hunter was later identified as Hunter Michael Schlotterbeck,

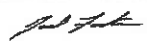
Chief Marker confirmed that Hunter was not injured and walked him out of the crime scene area for Hunter to later be interviewed by Detectives.

Detectives from the Washington County Sheriff's Office learned of this incident and began to respond to Columbia Machine Inc. As Detectives were responding, at that time there was limited information regarding what had occurred or who the suspect was.

At approximately 2:30 PM Detective Clayton Stottlemeyer of the Washington County Sheriff's Office responded to Columbia Machine, located
for the report of an active assailant. Upon arrival at the address, Detective Stottlemeyer assisted Captain Mark Knight, Sergeant Alan Matheny, and Detective Casey Swope in clearing the business.

While clearing the structure Detective Stottlemeyer observed two, obviously deceased in a garage bay of the business. It is to be noted that several spent casings were observed near both males and strewn throughout the garage bay. Once the business was deemed secure, Detectives began to interview witnesses outside of the business.

Detective Stottlemeyer interviewed the general manager of Columbia Machine, Tom Andrew Neil,
Tom reported that he arrived at

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Columbia Machine at approximately 7:00 AM on June 9, 2022, as he normally does. Tom shared that his employees were already at the business and were actively working. Further, Tom stated that his employees always arrive to work one-hour prior to him.

Moreover, Tom reported that once he arrived at the business, he proceeded to complete a walk-through of the work floor. While walking the work floor, Tom went through and talked to his employees. Eventually, Tom went to his office and began working on quotes and other miscellaneous administrative duties.

Tom shared that as the work day progressed, he completed several walk throughs of the work floor and spoke to all of his employees. Tom estimated that at approximately 2:00 PM, he returned to his office to conduct a conference call. Tom reported between 2:30 PM and 2:40 PM, he heard several gun shots coming from the work floor. Tom estimated that the gunfire was rapid, and he estimated that twelve total rounds were fired with a brief intermission between gunfire. Further, Tom reported that as the shooting began, he ran to the office adjacent to his to contact an employee named Dawn.

Upon contact with Dawn, Tom directed her to call 911 to report the incident. While conversing with Dawn, Tom observed an employee, Brandon Michael, fleeing from the work floor to a field adjacent to the business. Tom reported that he ran outside to contact Brandon in order to determine what was happening and learned that an employee, "Joe Esquivel", was actively shooting at employees on the work floor. Tom followed Brandon into the field and had him lay down, as he had been shot. Joe was later identified as Joe Louis Esquivel,

Tom reported that as he and Brandon lay in the field, he observed Joe fleeing the business in an . Tom noted that he last saw Joe traveling on Bikle Road towards Smithsburg Pike.

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Furthermore, Tom reported that once Joe fled from the scene, he went back to the business in order to ensure 911 was called. After doing so, Tom walked through the business to count his employees. In doing so, Tom observed that employees Mark Frey, Josh Wallace, and Charles Minnick were deceased in the business. After all employees were accounted from, Tom exited the business and waited on Law Enforcement to arrive.

The deceased were later identified as Mark Alan Frey
, Charles Edward Minnick Jr,
and Joshua Robert Wallace,
victims sustained gunshot wounds.

All three

Detective Swope the located a witness that was working across the street at Mace Auto Body. The witness identified himself as Lloyd Daniel Martz,

Lloyd stated he heard what he thought was an "air nailer" going off multiple times. Lloyd explained he looked across the street and observed men running from the building and trying to hide in the field. Lloyd stated he then saw a

"fly" down the business lane towards Bikle Road. Lloyd stated he ran across the street to the men located in the field and helped rendered aid.

At approximately 3:15 P.M, Detective Swope spoke to Dawn Marie Greene,

Dawn stated she is the office manager for the business. Dawn explained she was sitting in her office talking to "Mannie" who was later identified as Manuel E Mendez. Dawn explained she heard a loud bang that went off approximately six (6) to seven (7) times. Dawn stated the General Manager Tom, who was identified as Tom Andrew Neil, came over to her location and asked, "What was that?"

Dawn stated while she was calling 911, she saw Brandon, who was later identified as

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Brandon Chase Michael, , running outside past her window. Dawn then observed "Joe's" car leave the business traveling towards Bikle Road. It should be noted that Joe was identified "Joe" as Joe Esquivel. Dawn stated "Joe" parked his car beside the white Ford pick-up truck to the northside of the building.

Detective Swope asked Dawn if there have been any issues with "Joe" or any other workers. Dawn stated she did not know of any issues. Dawn explained "Joe" had started coming into work late, but this week had been fine, and he was on time. Dawn stated she believes that "Joe" lives in West Virginia and she didn't know much about him or any family.

At approximately 2:36 PM Detective Andrew Koontz and Detective Sergeant Bryan Glines were informed that there were numerous casualties at Columbia Machine Inc., on Bikle Road, and were enroute to that scene. As Detective Glines and Detective Koontz were enroute they learned that the suspect was operating an westbound on Jefferson Boulevard.

Detectives were then informed that Maryland State Police Troopers had contacted the suspect vehicle at the traffic circle at Mapleville Road and Mount Aetna Road. Detective Glines and Detective Koontz were not far from that location, therefore they diverted to that scene to assist as needed.

Detectives learned that the suspect vehicle, , was driven by Joe Esquivel, and was involved in a shooting with Maryland State Troopers. Detectives learned that Joe was ultimately shot in return fire by Maryland State Police and was being treated by EMS at the scene. Officers located an , on the ground near Joe which was seized by Maryland State Police as evidence.

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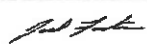
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Detective Glines and Detective Koontz arrived at the scene at Mapleville Road and Mount Aetna Road and observed numerous police vehicles and a large full size . There was a in the truck that appeared shaken and indicated that she was a witness. Detective Koontz walked over to the truck and the female identified as Ashley Nichole Palmer,

Ashley said that she was driving in her vehicle and there was an car in front of her truck. When traveling in the area of the traffic circle she witnessed a Police cruiser travel past her vehicle with lights and sirens and drive in front of the vehicle causing it to stop. Ashley said that she witnessed police get out of the cruiser and then she heard an exchange of gunfire. Ashley said that she witnessed the driver of the vehicle put his hands out the driver's side window of the vehicle. Ashley said that she believed there might have been more shots fired. Ashley said that an unmarked police truck then pulled up behind the car and blocked her vision. Ashley said she saw a Trooper that she believed suffered a gunshot wound and officers began caring for him. Ashley did not witness anything further but was instructed to stay on scene to speak with Maryland State Police Detectives.

Detective Glines learned that Joe Esquivel was going to be transported to Meritus Medical Center for treatment. Detective Glines instructed Deputy Nolan Carbaugh to ride with Joe in the ambulance to Meritus Medical Center.

Deputy Carbaugh later advised that while enroute to Meritus Medical Center Joe stated, "you need to raid my neighbor's house there are unregistered firearms and suppressors" the suspect continued to state, "The people I shot were pedophiles." Deputy Carbaugh arrived at Meritus Medical Center where Joe was treated for his injuries. Detective Glines later reviewed the body camera footage from Deputy Carbaugh. Refer to Detective Glines' supplemental report for details regarding the statements made by Joe Esquivel while in the ambulance.

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At approximately 3:30 P.M. Detective Sergeant Chris Weaver and Detective Sergeant Howard Ward responded to Meritus Medical Center located at
Detective Ward and Detective Weaver contacted Brandon Chase Michael,

Brandon explained to Detective Weaver that around 2:30 P.M., he "Josh, CJ, Mark and Hunter" went into the break room. Brandon stated he was sitting at a table looking down at his phone when he heard four (4) gunshots. Brandon looked up and saw "Joe" walking into the breakroom holding a gun. Brandon stated he felt himself get hit by a bullet and then got up and ran out of the room. Brandon stated "Joe" was holding a handgun. Brandon stated he knows and works with "Joe."

Detective Glines and Detective Koontz were informed that this scene was being handled by Maryland State Police. As a result, Detectives Koontz and Glines immediately responded to the address on

Whenever Detective Glines and Detective Koontz arrived at Detective Koontz was directed to a witness of the shooting who would be identified as Manuel E. Mendez, a Detective Koontz asked Manuel if he could record the conversation and he agreed. Manuel said that he was getting ready to leave work for the day and was talking to a female in the office. Manuel said that he heard gunshots or loud banging coming somewhere in the building. Manuel said that he opened a door and observed a co-worker he knows as "Joe" actively shooting at people in the place of business. Manuel said that he observed Joe holding a handgun and then he immediately began running out of the building.

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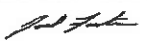
Manuel said that he ran out of the building with other employees into a field in the direction of Bikle Road. Another employee he knows as "Branden" suffered a gunshot wound to the and Manuel took off his belt and began using it as a tourniquet. Manuel said that he witnessed "Joe" leave the business in the car that he knows is "Joes". Manuel witnessed "Joe" turn left onto Jefferson Boulevard out of his view.

Detective Koontz talked about Joe's employment with the business, and he said that Joe was a machinist the company and other than just being relatively a quiet person he didn't really know much about Joe. Manuel said that on this date in question Joe was working and there were no real issues at work. Manuel did say that Joe messed up something on a part that he was making, and Joe came to Manuel about it. Manuel said that it was really no big deal, and no one confronted him about it or got into an argument about it. Manuel said that at approximately 10 minutes later is when Joe started shooting. Manuel was later transported to the Smithsburg Police Department.

Detective Jason Ackerman, from Hagerstown City Police Department, was assisting Detectives at Columbia Machine Inc., spoke with Hunter Michael Schlotterbeck, , who is a CNC machinist at Columbia Machine Inc. and has been there for approximately 1 year.

Hunter advised that on June 9, 2022, during their 2:30 PM break in the break room in the designated break room located in the southeast corner of Columbia Machine, Inc. Hunter described the break room as an isolated room having two exits/entrances. One of the exits/entrances is located on the north side of the room that leads to the bay opening to the north side of the building. The second exit/entrance is on the east side of the room that leads to the south side of the building.

Hunter recalled being on break with his fellow co-workers, 'CJ', 'Manuel', 'Josh', 'Brandon', and 'Mark'. Hunter stated that he (Hunter) was seated by the water cooler when

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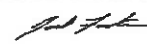
he observed another co-worker, 'Joe', enter the break room from the north exit/entrance of the room. Hunter advised that Joe was in the possession of a that Joe fired 2 to 3 times in the break room. Hunter believed that he watched 'Mark' and 'Brandon' fall to the floor as Hunter turned towards the east side exit. As hunter fled the building he heard 2 to 3 more gunshots being fired.

Hunter made his way out of the bay opening on the south side of the building and hid behind a large trailer sized refuse container. Hunter ran around the east side of the building to the north side, where he encountered Joe running out of the bay opening on the north side of the building. Hunter advised that Joe pointed the black pistol at Hunter, at which time Hunter ducked behind some pallets for cover. No additional shots were fired.

Hunter watched Joe get into his , that had a , and flee the scene in the vehicle. Hunter then was able to call 911 to report this incident. For further details regarding the interview with Hunter, refer to the supplemental report provided by Detective Ackerman.

Once all witnesses were spoken to regarding the shooting, Detective Glines began to author an application for an arrest warrant for Joe Esquivel. As Detective Glines was preparing this document, Detective Glines learned that there was confusion on who Joe Esquivel actually was. There was another person named Jose Alfredo Esquivel, . This contradicted what had been told, therefore Detectives worked to determine which Joe Esquivel was in custody. Through extensive research, it was found that Joe Louis Esquivel, with the date of birth of , was the correct name to the suspect in custody.

Detective Glines obtained an ARREST WARRANT for Joe Esquivel be charged with all applicable charges based on the information herein.

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Detective Glines received information during the infancy stages of this investigation that Joe Esquivel was relaying information to Deputy Carbaugh that there could be more than one active threat. Detective Glines learned that Joe was giving information that the police needed to raid houses in his neighborhood.

Detectives were told that there was a male named, "John Wieman" who lived somewhere near Joe that Joe had purchased illegal automatic weapons from. Detectives were researching any information that they could find to identify and locate John Wieman. Detective Glines also found that Joe's address is . Detective Glines contacted Detective Thomas Funk, with Berkeley County Sheriff's Office in West Virginia, for assistance in securing that residence. It was believed that there could be more illegal firearms or any evidence of planning of this incident at that address.

On June 9, 2022, at approximately 5:51 PM, Detective Funk contacted Detective Glines and advised that Deputies from the Berkeley County Sheriff's Office had the address secured. Detective Funk told Detective Glines that inside of the residence Deputies located , Jose Perez Esquivel, , and Ashley Rachell Esquivel, . Detective Glines later provided a narrative to this incident to Detective Funk for Detectives in West Virginia to author a search and seizure warrant.

Sergeant Edward Witanowski, from the Maryland State Police, conducted a search of the name "John Wieman" through computer databases and was able to locate a male named John Jacob Wieman III, who resides at the . Detective Glines provided this information to Detective Funk who then had Deputies secure that residence as well.

Due to information obtained through this investigation, with the statements made by Joe Esquivel, Detectives in West Virginia were able to obtain a search and seizure warrant for John Wieman's address as well. Detective Funk located numerous firearms from both John Wieman's address as well as from Joe Esquivel's address. Detective Funk later provided Detective Glines with reports that detailed the events that occurred in West Virginia during this investigation. Also, Detective Sergeant Howard Ward was present during the search of Joe Esquivel's residence. Refer to Detective Ward's supplemental report for further details.

Detective Lieutenant Joel Footen spoke with FBI Agent Karen Cody, who advised that due to the severity of this crime scene that the FBI would provide a team of Crime Scene Technicians to assist with processing the scene. Crime Scene Technician Amy Adamson and Crime Scene Technician Rebecca Anderson from the Western Maryland Crime Laboratory arrived at Columbia Machine Inc. and contacted the FBI Crime Scene Technicians to work alongside of them. As the Crime Scene Technicians began to work through the Crime Scene, Detectives from the Washington County Sheriff's Office were able to walk through the scene as well.

Detective Glines entered the garage bay door located to the north of the building and walked onto the main floor of the shop. Detective Glines observed across the interior of the building two deceased males lying on the floor outside of the break room. Detective Glines identified Charles Minnick, Jr. lying on the floor face down near the exit/entrance to the east side of the break room. Just north of Charles, Detective Glines identified Joshua Wallace lying face down on the floor as well. Both Charles and Joshua were face down in a pool of blood. Detective Glines walked into the break room and observed Mark Frey lying on the floor on the southwest side of the room, face down. Mark was also lying in a pool of blood. All three victims suffered multiple gunshot wounds.

Detectives also located four cellular telephones in the break room, one being identified as Brandon Michael's cellular telephone. Those phones were collected by the Western Maryland Crime Laboratory and handed to Detectives. Brandon Michael had his cell phone returned to him at Meritus Medical Center at a later time. The other three phones have

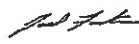
been identified as Mark Frey, Charles Minnick, and Joshua Wallace's cell phones. Those cell phones have been placed into Washington County Sheriff's Office property.

Detectives walked through the building and observed front offices that belonged to Tom, the General Manager, and Dawn, the secretary of Columbia Machine, Inc. Detectives observed Dawn's purse sitting on her desk, which was retrieved by Detectives and later returned to Dawn. Detectives also located a cellular telephone on the desk that belonged to Tom. That cell phone was also collected and later returned to Tom.

Detectives found a printout of the background information from Columbia Machine, Inc., for Joe Esquivel. This printout had the personal information of Joe to include full name, address, date of birth, telephone number, email address, and his signature. At the top of the printout the word, "Suspect", is written and underlined. Detective Glines later learned that Chief Marker was obtaining that information from Tom before exiting the building, however Chief Marker left that paper on the desk. This paper was collected as evidence.

Once the FBI and Western Maryland Crime Laboratory were finished processing the scene, Forensic Examiner Bradley Dwyer arrived to do an examination Mark Frey, Charles Minnick, and Joshua Wallace. Once Bradley Dwyer was finished, all three were transported to the Chief Medical Examiner's Office in Baltimore, Maryland, for autopsies. The transport company, Heartfelt Livery Service, transported all three victims. The medical examiner's report numbers for each are the following: Mark Frey (22-07895), Charles Minnick (22-07896), and Joshua Wallace (22-07892).

On Friday, June 10, 2022, at approximately 8:15 PM, Deputy Michael Hill of the Washington County Sheriff's Office, responded to Meritus Medical Center and served Joe Esquivel with the arrest warrants stemming from the Bikle Road incident and the investigation being handle by Maryland State Police at the traffic circle. 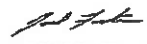

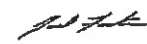

Tom reported that he ran outside to contact Brandon in order to determine what was happening and learned that an employee, Joe Esquivel, was actively shooting at employees on the work floor. Tom followed Brandon into the field and had him lay down, as he had been shot.

Tom reported that as he had Brandon lay in the field, he observed Joe fleeing the business in an
Tom noted that he last saw Joe traveling on

Furthermore, Tom reported that once Joe fled from the scene, he went back to the business in order to ensure 911 was called. After doing so, Tom walked through the business to count his employees. In doing so, Tom observed that employees Mark Frey, Josh Wallace, and Charles Minnick were deceased in the business. After all employees were accounted from, Tom exited the business and waited on Law Enforcement to arrive.

In addition to obtaining the aforementioned information from Tom, Detective Stottlemeyer asked Tom to describe what kind of employee Joe was. As a result, Tom reported that Joe had been employed by _____ for approximately seven months as a machine operator. Tom shared that Joe was quiet and stayed to himself. Further, Tom reported that Joe did not display any indicators that would have made Tom worry that he was going to commit violence in the workplace. Tom noted that Joe was satisfactory employee and his employee performance evaluations were positive.

DFC Montenegro ran into the building with an active assailant medical bag and first encountered office manager Dawn Greene who told DFC Montenegro that there were victims in the work area. DFC Montenegro continued to the work area where he saw Smithsburg Police Chief Marker and another (later identified as general manager Tom Andrew Neil) and they motioned towards the corner of the building where the break room is. DFC Montenegro saw two males on the ground with what appeared to be multiple gunshot wounds. DFC Montenegro checked for signs of life, but they both appeared to be obviously deceased. DFC Montenegro observed just inside the break room that there was a third , also with gunshot wounds, and also obviously deceased.

An Emergency Medical Services paramedic arrived on scene immediately after DFC Montenegro, and DFC Montenegro asked him to verify that the victims were deceased beyond life saving

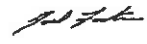

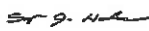

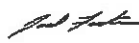

Ward observed multiple people around tending to a subject lying on the ground. The male was positively identified as Joe Louis Esquivel, through his West Virginia driver's license. Eventually, Esquivel was loaded into an ambulance and transported to Meritus Medical Center. Esquivel's home address listed on his West Virginia driver's license

At this time, D/Sgt. Ward had Deputy Weaver wrap the perimeter of the scene with caution tape. At approximately 3:17PM, D/Sgt. Ward started a crime scene log. D/Sgt. Ward maintained the log until 4:19PM, until this log was transferred to Trooper Socks of the Maryland State Police. D/Sgt. Ward photographed the log just before handing the forms over. The photograph of the crime scene log will accompany this supplement. D/Sgt. Ward received a telephone call from Deputy Carbaugh. Deputy Carbaugh advised D/Sgt. Ward that he received information from Esquivel regarding a friend of his wanting to do something similar to what he had done. Deputy Carbaugh provided the name John Weiman (No further information). D/Sgt. Ward then contacted Lt. Footen and advised him of the information just learned. Once the scene was turned over to MSP, D/Sgt. Ward responded to Meritus Medical Center (MMC) located at

While en-route to MMC, D/Sgt. Ward contacted Captain Hall with the Berkeley County Sheriff's Office in West Virginia. D/Sgt. Ward informed Captain Hall of the incident that occurred in Washington County, as well as the suspect (Esquivel) residing in West Virginia.

Ward asked Joe what he thought his son meant by that statement. Joe advised his son was scared to die and that he wanted to sell his house because of the people around the area.

Joe advised his son has resided in Hedgesville West Virginia for approximately three years. Joe made mention that one of his neighbors was the "main" guy. As Joe was elaborating, he advised his son passed by one time and the neighbor called him a "beaner". Joe advised that the neighbor's wife one day made the comment to his son "they haven't killed your bean ass yet". Joe advised this altercation occurred over a year ago. It was determined that Joe was referring to the neighbor "John Weiman". Joe advised Weiman and his son are not friends.

D/Sgt. Ward asked Joe to back up the conversation to when he was speaking to his son last night. 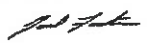

Knight #3875 and DFC J. Montenegro #9679. I observed a seated along Bikle Road. I later verified that he was a witness that had helped the injured survivor that was in the field. There were several EMS vehicles and personnel in the driveway and in the area of a field to the north of the building. I recognized this field (and later verified) as the field that Officer Moralas had found the first victim. Officer Moralas was not on scene, and according to his radio transmission, he was with the victim en route to the hospital.

I was given a wallet from the witness (and EMS) that was sitting on Bikle Road at the field next to building. I was told that it belonged to the victim that was shot. This was the victim that Officer Moralas had first contacted that had been in the field. As this was early in the incident, I put the wallet in my front left pocket.

Among other tasks, I managed or ensured that the following was completed:

Coordinated all activities with Incident Command.

Coordinated all criminal investigative matters with Lt. Footen #6317 and his CIU team of investigators and forensic team.

Ensured that the building had been cleared of threats and that all injured individuals had received medical attention.

Set up an external perimeter using crime scene/police tape and police to ensure the integrity and safety of the scene. DFC. S. Buskirk #5773 was placed in charge of the outer perimeter.

Have a deputy check with each adjacent resident to ensure no one was injured and to see if they had seen or heard anything or had video of the incident.

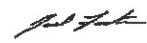

I arrived at the scene I learned the suspect was located driving his vehicle and was stopped by the Maryland State Police. I then left the crime scene and went back to Meritus to attempt to interview the suspect.

I asked Brandon what happened next. He stated he felt himself get shot and ran out of the break room. He stated he ran outside and knowing the business was fenced in with only one way in and out, he said he ran through the gate so he wouldn't be trapped inside. He said when he fell in the field he looked back at the business and saw Joe run out of the building and get in his car and drive through the gate and away from the plant. I asked him if he knew what kind of car Joe drove. Mr. Michael said it was a

I then spoke with States Attorney Gina Cirnicione who was also at Meritus. I told her Joe and Jose are very similar in name, and the possibility existed a person could use the name "Joe" in place of Jose. I advised her we had a MVA photograph of a Jose Esquivel who had the same last name, but the date of birth was different than what had on the suspect. I asked her if we could show Brandon the photograph of Jose Esquivel to possibly obtain a positive identification of a suspect and see if Joe and Jose were the same person.

Ms. Cirnicione agreed to show him the photograph to see if the person in the MVA photograph was who shot him. I then went back into Brandon's room and asked him if he would look at a photograph and see if he recognized the person. He agreed to look at the photograph. I then showed him Jose Esquivel's MVA photograph that was provided to DFC Angelini. Mr. Michael stated the person resembled Joe but he said the person in the picture wasn't him.

When I finished his Miranda rights I asked him what was going to happen. He stated people invaded the capital and installed "2K" listening devices. He stated they were trying to overthrow the government and they needed to be stopped. TPR Schramm asked where we could find them to stop them and he stated they worked at APX enclosures. (APX enclosures is a manufacturing plant located in Greencastle Pennsylvania) He stated we needed to raid their houses.

I asked Joe where they live and he said he didn't know. I then asked him how he was contacting them. He didn't answer the question and just stated these people are trying to overthrow the government and we need to stop them, there bad people.

I asked Joe if he was talking about the people he shot or the other people. He stated it was the people he shot. I then asked him when he shot them and he replied, today. TPR Schramm asked him if they were people he worked with and Joe stated yes he worked with them "right now."

TPR Schramm asked him what they did to him. Joe stated they kept him under threats working there trying to overthrow the government. TPR asked him if the people he shot today were trying to overthrow the government also and he replied yes. TPR Schramm asked if they were different from Ricky and John. Joe then stated Ricky stormed the capitol and

installed mind control devices.

TPR Schramm asked him if they told him all of this today and Joe stated they have mind control devices and we need to investigate them. He stated there all veterans.

TPR Schramm asked him again what happened today after "they" told Joe "they" were going to make his family brain dead. Joe said he didn't want that to happen. TPR asked Joe what he did then and Joe stated, "I shot them." TPR Schramm asked Joe where he shot them and Joe stated,

I then asked Joe if he used his gun and he stated yes. I asked him if he took it in with him and he stated yes.

Joe then stated "they" had him under threats and were going to kill his mother.

TPR Schramm asked him what happened after he shot the people today and Joe replied he drove away. TPR Schramm asked him what happened after he drove away and Joe said he came here (hospital). TPR Schramm asked him what car he drove away in and Joe replied a

He stated we needed to raid his house to get the suppressors and machine guns.

TPR Schramm asked him what John's house looked like and Joe replied a normal house. Joe then again stated, "they" are involved in human trafficking and pedophiles and when he found out he didn't want any parts of it.

TPR Schramm asked Joe if he had other guns in house and he stated he did.

TPR Schramm asked Joe if there was anything else we needed to know before we got started. Joe stated we needed to investigate Doug Weller. TPR Schramm asked him what he did and Joe replied he was a mold inspector. Joe replied these people are up to no good, he's a veteran with unregistered machine guns and suppressors. I cleared the hospital and returned to the crime scene. While there I spoke with Det. Casey Swope who was inside the crime scene assisting the forensic investigators while they were gathering evidence. She asked me during my interview of the victim of the shooting, Brandon Michael, if he stated which door the suspect used to walk into the break room. I told her he did not. She stated there were two doors to the break room and the forensic investigators wanted to know if we could find out which door Brandon saw him come through.

She stated one door to the break room was adjacent to a large garage type door and another door was located towards the shop area. I told her I could return to Meritus to talk to him.

I then cleared the crime scene and returned to Meritus. Brandon had been admitted to the hospital and was transported to a room upstairs from the trauma center. I located Brandon and he was awake and alert. I asked him what door the suspect walked through when he entered the break room. She stated Joe he was sitting at a table in the break room looking at his phone. He stated Joe walked in the door located towards the shop area. He then asked me if we recovered his cell phone. He stated he was most likely still on the table where he was sitting. He described it as red and black. I contacted Det. Swope and told her what Brandon had told me. I then asked her if they located a red and black cell phone which was Brandon's phone. She stated it was laying on a table in the break room which was most likely where Brandon was sitting.

Det/Sgt Glines is the lead investigator in this investigation.

As I was responding to the scene it was determined this address was the and radio transmissions indicated there were possibly more shooting victims inside the building.

I arrived at approximately 1440 hours pulling through the main gate and positioning my patrol vehicle to the north side of the main entrance. I saw Deputy First Class J. Montenegro exiting the front main door and he told me what he knew at that time. I entered the main door and made my way to the shop area where I observed three shooting victims that all appeared to be deceased and had already been checked by DFC J. Montenegro and EMS personnel. The EMS personnel said there was an employee that had not been accounted for and a search was initiated for him at which time he was located.

I was joined by Sergeant A. Matheny, Deputies C. Stottlemeyer, C. Swope. We cleared (searched) the building area and determined there was no employees or suspects still in the building so that the crime scene could be secured.

The entire building and property are fenced in and as Sgt. Kemmerer arrived, he took charge of securing the perimeter of the fenced in area with police/sheriff's office personnel and areas interest were marked off with police caution tape. All witness were moved outside the fenced area until met with detectives from the Sheriff's Office and the Hagerstown Police Department.

I assisted with command post operations until I left the scene at 0030 hours on 06/10/2022.

On Friday, June 10, 2022, Detective Stottlemeyer responded to the Office of the Chief Medical Examiner for the State of Maryland in order to collect evidence for this case. Upon arrival, Detective Stottlemeyer met with Assistant Medical Examiner, Dr. Vincenti.

Dr. Vincenti informed Detective Stottlemeyer that she was responsible for completing the autopsies of Mark Frey, Charles Minnick, and Joshua Wallace. Dr. Vincenti shared that at the time of Detective Stottlemeyer's arrival, she had only been able to complete Mark's autopsy. Dr. Vincenti noted that each autopsy was going to be time-consuming since each of the three victims' had sustained several gunshot wounds. Furthermore, Dr. Vincenti directed Detective Stottlemeyer to the observation tower to wait while she completed the autopsies of Charles and Joshua.

Once in the observation tower, Detective Stottlemeyer observed the autopsies of both Charles and Joshua. During both autopsies, Dr. Vincenti recovered projectiles from both victims' bodies. Additional details pertaining to the type of projectile and the exact location of the located projectile can be found in Dr. Vincenti's reports.

After all three autopsies were complete, Detective Stottlemeyer met with Dr. Vincenti. In doing so, Dr. Vincenti provided Detective Stottlemeyer with the evidence she had collected during the autopsies, as well as the clothing worn by the victims at the time of their murders. Prior to leaving the Office of the Chief Medical Examiner for the State of Maryland, Dr. Vincenti told Detective Stottlemeyer that unofficially, she believed that Mark had been shot seven times, Charles had been shot five times, and Joshua had been shot nine times. Dr. Vincenti noted that the aforementioned count was unofficial, as those numbers were subject to change as she continued to analyze the wounds. Furthermore, Dr.

Vincenti reported that her final report, which will later be provided to Detective/Sergeant Glines, will reflect the official number of gunshot wounds sustained by each victim.

Once the evidence was collected, Detective Stottlemeyer transported the evidence back to Washington County, Maryland. Once back in Washington County, Maryland, Detective Stottlemeyer and Detective/Sergeant Glines placed the evidence related to Joshua in the dryer at the Washington County Sheriff's Office. Additionally, the Detectives placed the evidence related to Mark and Charles into the dryers located at the Hagerstown Police Department. It is to be noted that all three dryers were secured for the duration of the time that the evidence was drying.

On Monday, June 13, 2022, Detective Stottlemeyer and Detective/Sergeant Ward retrieved the evidence from the Hagerstown Police Department and transported it to the Washington County Sheriff's Office. Once at the Washington County Sheriff's Office, Detective Stottlemeyer, Detective/Sergeant Ward, and Washington County Sheriff's Office Property Manager, Joe Artman, processed, packaged, and entered all of the evidence collected from the Office of the Chief Medical Examiner into the property via the Washington County Sheriff's Office SAFE Evidence Management System.

This case remains assigned to Detective/Sergeant Glines.

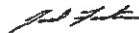

Joe was continuously stating the same things over and over as he was being loaded into the ambulance from Mapleville Road / Mount Aetna Road, to be transported to Meritus Medical Center. Carbaugh was in the ambulance with Maryland State Police Medic Greg Lance and EMS Personnel James Ulrich.

Joe was stating that he was a member of a Right-Wing extremist group and bought his firearms from his neighbor, "John Jacob Wieman". Joe was asked by Maryland State Police Medic Greg Lance if Joe had any explosives on him or at his house and Joe stated that he did not. Maryland State Police Medic Greg Lance also asked Joe if he was on any drugs/narcotics and Joe stated that he was not.

As Joe was lying on the gurney he said, "Are you listening to me?". Once the EMS Personnel James Ulrich stated that they were, Joe stated that his neighbors' houses needed raided and that he purchased his machine gun from "John Jacob Wieman", and that he is a part of a Right-Wing extremist group trying to overthrow the Government and that they broke into the Capital and stole "V2K" devices. Joe then states again that he purchased his machine gun from John Jacob Wieman and that there is another person that has full auto weapons that lives behind him named, "John J Breachbill". That name is unconfirmed at this time based on Joe rambling while in the ambulance and was hard to understand completely. Joe then states that he has a fully automatic PS-90 just before Maryland State Police Medic Greg

Lance placed an oxygen bag on Joe's mouth. Joe is heard saying, "You're going to have to do these raids or something worse is going to happen".

Joe then says that there is a big Right-Wing Extremist group in his neighborhood with members from Hagerstown, Maryland. Joe says again that he purchased his PS-90 from John Jacob Wieman and that it would be found when police raided his house. The medic then asked Joe if he had any explosives at his house and Joe said that he did not, that he only had unregistered machine guns.

Joe says again that they were manufacturing illegal/unregistered machine guns in his neighborhood with "John J Breachbill" and "John Jacob Wieman" were a part of the group and that they were friends with Mark Alan Frey. Joe then stated that they were manufacturing "V2K" devices and that they were a part of a pedophile (sex) ring.

Joe then states that he was a part of a big far Right-Wing extremist group and stated, "I killed them because I found out they were pedophiles, Mark Alan Frey was a pedophile and he raped my sister, I didn't find out until later, that's why I killed him". The EMS Personnel James Ulrich then grabbed Joe's attention and began to ask him questions.

The EMS personnel asked Joe what his name was and Joe responded, "Joe Esquivel" and spelled his last name. EMS personnel asked Joe what Joe's birthday was and Joe responded, . EMS personnel asked Joe where Joe lived and Joe responded, . Joe told the EMS personnel that the FBI and ATF needed to raid his neighbors' houses because they all had unregistered machine guns.

As EMS personnel were speaking with Joe, Joe said again that he killed Mark Alan Frey because Mark raped his sister and that Mark was a pedophile. Joe said, "I didn't know they

were pedophiles, that's why I did it". Joe stated, "It I die, you gotta tell them everything I was telling you. You gotta do these raids. I just want to get that off my chest before I die".

As the ambulance arrived at Meritus Medical Center, Joe was still speaking about the FBI having to do raids at houses in his neighborhood. Joe then stated that they installed the V2K device when they raided the Capital and that Ricky Musselman was the co-founder, and then Joe's voice was muffled. Joe was then taken into the Emergency Room to be treated for his injuries.

Detective Glines and Detective Koontz caused a search of "V2K" devices and found that "V2K" is a real device that is a technology that was discovered in 1962 by Doctor Allan H. Frey and is called the "Frey Effect". It should be noted that Mark Alan Frey is one of the victims that Joe shot that was one of his co-workers. Detectives have found no evidence that any of the co-workers at , are pedophiles or are in any way related to, or connected to Doctor Allan H. Frey, the creator of V2K devices. As Detective Glines was researching V2K Detective Glines noticed that the websites that were found reference "TI". The term, "TI" was found to be an abbreviation for "Targeted Individual".

Once Joe was in stable condition Detective Sergeant Weaver spoke with Joe in reference to this investigation. Detective Weaver read Joe his Miranda Warning and Joe agreed to waive his Rights voluntarily and speak with Detectives.

Joe continued to state the same things, that he was a part of an extreme Right-Wing group with the plans to overthrow the Government. Joe brought up the name, "Ricky Musselman", "John Jacob Wieman", and "John Breachbill", as being a part of this group. Joe also stated that Mark Alan Frey was also a part of this group.

It should be noted that Deputies and Detectives were with Ashley while in West Virginia and at no point in time did Ashley mention being raped by anyone to any police officer.

When Joe is asked simple questions regarding where he worked, what day it is, and other specific things, Joe is aware of everything. Joe is asked if he shot people that he has mentioned already, referring to John Jacob Wieman, John Breachman, or Ricky Musselman, and Joe stated that he shot other people. Joe advised that Mark Alan Frey was another member of this group as well as someone named Doug Weller and some other guys, were using V2K devices and TI's. Joe then stated that the police needed to raid their houses, that they were raping people. Detective Weaver asked Joe if Joe was speaking about the people that Joe shot or all of the other people Joe was mentioning. Joe stated, "The people I shot". Detective Weaver asked Joe when he shot those people and Joe answered, "Today".

Detective Weaver continued to speak with Joe and for further details regarding the interview refer to Detective Weaver's supplemental report.

On Monday, June 27th, 2022, at approximately 1:30PM, Special Agent David Rauser with the Federal Bureau of Investigations contacted D/Sgt. Ward at the Washington County Sheriff's Office. SA Rauser provided D/Sgt. Ward with a thumb drive that contained the phone download of John Weiman, and another thumb drive that contained the phone download of Viktor Fedtsov. SA Rauser learned that Fedtsov was an associate of Esquivel and conducted an interview in attempt to gain more information on Esquivel. SA Rauser did advise during his interview with Fedtsov that a change in Esquivel's behavior was noticed recently.

Information was being relayed that there were other gunshot victims inside the business, as well.

While responding, Det. Lt. Footen also learned that the suspect vehicle was stopped in the area of Rt.66 and Mt. Aetna Rd. by Maryland State Police. There was no other information being heard on channel WCSO-1 as to the status of the suspect or what was happening at that time, but Det. Lt. Footen later learned that there was a shootout between the suspect and MSP troopers and that the suspect was shot, as well as a trooper. Det. Lt. Footen and Det. Sgt. Glines then coordinated for Det. were numerous MSP personnel on-scene on Rt.66/Mt. Aetna Rd. and that WCSO detectives were not needed there at the time. All WCSO detectives were then directed to

Prior to arriving to the scene, Det. Lt. Footen also spoke with other WCSO personnel, and learned there were multiple casualties at , but the exact number was still being determined. With the type of situation that was unfolding and the need for multiple resources, Det. Lt. Footen contacted Karen Cody from the FBI and informed her that WCSO was responding to an active shooter scene with multiple casualties and requested assistance from the FBI in terms of crime scene management, crime scene processing, and possible victim/family crisis assistance due to fatalities.

As Det. Lt. Footen arrived on-scene, he met with Sgt. Patrick Kemmerer who was coordinating the patrol deputy response and directing arriving units to different posts for crime scene security and other tasks. It was then established that Sgt. Kemmerer would be the direct supervisor for the patrol-level operations and Det. Lt. Footen would be the direct supervisor for the investigative operations. A command post was established outside of the fence-line at and the Mobile Command Center (MCC-1) was brought to the location for a formal command center.

Det. Lt. Footen then spoke with Trooper Jonathan Martin of the Maryland State Police and it was determined that WCSO would handle the investigation and charges for the events that took place at , and MSP would handle the investigation and charges for the events that occurred at the traffic stop on Rt.66/Mt. Aetna Rd.

During the initial investigation at , Det. Lt. Footen remained at MCC-1 and coordinated with responding investigative support personnel, including the FBI, the ATF, and Western Maryland Regional Crime Lab. It was determined that the FBI's crime scene technicians would assist in the locating, processing and collecting of evidence with WMRCL personnel, and WMRCL would ultimately seize the evidence from the scene. Prior to anyone entering the scene, it was learned that the manager of , Thomas Neil, gave Det. Sgt. Glines consent for any police officer or resource to enter the business for the investigation and crime scene processing.

a different shooting that had not occurred yet. This information was being relayed from Det. Sgt. Howard Ward, who was receiving it from patrol deputies that were overhearing Esquivel talking while at the hospital. The information was that Esquivel had a neighbor that was allegedly manufacturing automatic firearms and was possibly going to be involved in a different shooting. Det. Lt. Footen then directed the other detectives to focus on the new information that was coming in and to track-down any leads as to who the neighbor was, and then police would respond to contact the neighbor and either intervene with any criminal activity and/or learn any possible information into the shooting at

From the information that the detectives obtained, Esquivel's neighbor was identified and Det. Sgt. Howard Ward responded to Berkeley County, WV, and met with Berkeley County Sheriff's Office members and agents with the ATF and continued the investigation there. Refer to Det. Sgt. Howard Ward's supplement for more details regarding the actions taken and information obtained in WV.

Ultimately, back at the FBI and WMRL processed the crime scene and collected all evidence that was located. WMRL took possession of the evidence, and then the medical examiner's office was notified that the scene was ready for a medical examiner to enter to view the three deceased bodies. Forensic Investigator Bradley Dwyer arrived on-scene, and then Det. Lt. Footen joined Dwyer and entered to view the scene. Det. Lt. Footen observed the three deceased victims from a distance and saw that they were all either inside, or just outside the break room as described by other deputies who initially entered the business to secure it upon their initial arrival. Det. Lt. Footen then exited the scene until Dwyer was finished with his examination of the scene/bodies and the three victims were taken from the scene and transported to the Chief Medical Examiner's Office in Baltimore for autopsy.

Once the bodies were removed, crime scene technicians cleared and the scene was able to be opened. Det. Lt. Footen and other detectives then went thru the business and secured all of the doors, at the request of the company. After the business door were secured, Det. Lt. Footen informed the patrol deputies maintaining security posts that they could shut down the scene and leave their posts, and all police units left the scene.

Further investigation into the shooting was conducted by WCSO CIU and Det. Sgt. Glines was assigned as the lead detective.

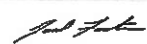

On Monday, July 11, 2022, Detective Sergeant Bryan Glines retrieved a Samsung Galaxy cellular telephone from the Washington County Sheriff's Office property to search through the cellular telephone. This is the cellular telephone that belongs to Joe Esquivel. Detective Glines also received two cellular forensic downloads from the Washington County Sheriff's Office property.

These cellular downloads are forensic downloads of the Samsung Galaxy cellular telephone as well as an iPhone SE cellular telephone. Both of these phones belonged to Joe Esquivel. The downloads were conducted by Sergeant J. Lee from the Maryland State Police.

Detective Glines reviewed the forensic cellular download for the Samsung Galaxy device and observed that the telephone number associated with this device is 304-886-1872. Detective Glines located two text messages that were sent to Joe's cellular telephone on June 9, 2022 at 2:55 PM. The text messages were from the number 304-886-1872, which is the telephone number for Ashley Rachel Esquivel. The text messages are as follows:

- June 9, 2022 / 2:55:12 PM From 304-886-1872 Wtf
- June 9, 2022 / 2:55:16 PM From 304-886-1872 Why'd u send 2000

Detective Glines believes that based on that text message there is a possibility that Joe had sent Ashley \$2,000 at some point. Detective Glines did not see any transactions that were made from this device, nor did Detective Glines see any indication that Joe utilized any applications to send any money as well.

Detective Glines continued to review content from this phone and located a conversation

through Snapchat between Detective Glines did confirm through the actual Samsung device that the account that is used by Joe Esquivel is "Joe ?" with the handle The message was the following:

- April 23, 2022 / 11:21:06 PM from : Is your uncle Mark Allen Frey

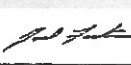
Detective Glines noticed that this message has been deleted, however it was able to be recovered during the forensic download. It should be noted that Mark Allen Frey is one of the victims in this investigation.

Detective Glines reviewed photographs in this device from the forensic download and found that Joe has numerous photographs of nude women, pornography, and firearms. Detective Glines located a photograph that appears to be a screenshot from YouTube of a text conversation from Salvador Ramos, who is the person who shot several children and teachers in a school shooting in Uvalde, Texas on May 24, 2022. The messages that have circulated through news outlets from Salvadore Ramos and an unknown female is the following:

- Salvadore: Ima tell you rn hold on
- Salvadore: Waiting for this (blank)
- Salvadore: Ima do something to her rn
- Salvadore: Omg
- Salvadore: Shes on the phone with AT&T abojt my phone
- Salvadore: It's annoying
- Salvadore: What
- Salvadore: I just shot my grandma in her head
- Salvadore: Ima go shoot up a elementary school rn
- Unknown Female: I just saw the news

Detective Glines also located a screenshot of the news showing the aerial view of Robb Elementary School during the investigation of the school shooting in Uvalde, Texas on May 24, 2022.

Detective Glines then located photographs that appeared to be photographs of another mobile device of employees that work at The employees are Jesse Ryan Allamong, Manual Anrique Mendez, and Mark Alan Frey. The photographs appeared to be on some kind of database for showing the employees that work at throughout the United States.

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Detective Glines searched the word "Frey" through Cellebrite Reader through the Samsung Galaxy download. Detective Glines found a conversation through Snapchat Application on April 23, 2022 / 11:21:06 PM where Joe sent to username "Is your uncle Mark Allen Frey". There was no response from and nowhere else in their conversation do they speak of Mark Allen Frey.

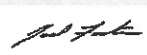
Detective Glines continued to search through the Samsung cellular telephone download and located several photographs that were screenshots or still photographs of electronic mind control. Joe appeared to be paranoid to some degree about mind control and "gangstalking" Detective Glines researched "Gangstalking" and found that it is a set of persecutory beliefs in which those affected believe they are being followed, stalked, and harassed by a large number of people. The term is associated with the targeted individual (T.I.) virtual community formed by like-minded individuals who claim their lives are disrupted from being stalked by organized groups intent on causing them harm.

Joe had several screenshots speaking of T.I.'s and "gangstalking" from a website called "4-chan". 4-chan is an unmonitored forum where people can speak freely about any sort of topic. Detectives found that most of the chats are written by "anonymous", which is not unusual for 4-Chan as they do not require any type of username or documentation of the authors.

Detective Glines also located on the Samsung download that Joe was researching all types of pornography such as bestiality, homosexual, and videos that are disturbing. Joe also had numerous photographs and video searches of legal age adult females who were either nude or partially nude with some of them performing sexual acts.

Detective Glines found on this Samsung download that on June 7, 2022, Joe had searched "EMF Radiation" numerous times as well as "numbness in head and dizziness. Joe also had searches on his phone related to "Weed Brain Fog" and had visited websites titled "Mass Murder, Targeted Individuals, and Gang-Stalking: Exploring the Connections/Violence and Gender".

Detective Glines then began to analyze the data that was from the iPhone SE that belongs to Joe Esquivel. Detective Glines began by searching through the images on the device and found a photograph or still shot of a Google image of the intersection of Rankestrasse and Tauntzienstrasse in Berlin, Germany. The photograph was created on the iPhone on June 8,

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2022 at 10:31:09 AM (UTC-4). Just above the intersection are the words, "Site of Incident".

Detective Glines caused a search to be made through the internet for incidents that occurred in Berlin, Germany in June, 2022, and found that on June 8, 2022 a person drove a vehicle onto the sidewalk at the intersection from the image on the iPhone that killed one person and injured 17 school students. According to news articles it is believed that the driver intentionally drove into the crowd of people attempting to kill as many as he could.

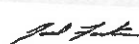
Detective Glines also located a photograph in the iPhone of a screenshot of a TikTok showing the suspects in Columbine High School massacre on April 20, 1999. The TikTok showed Dylan Klebold and Eric Harris in the school during the shootings. The TikTok was tagged as

Detective Glines also located several other screenshots/photographs in the iPhone to include a screenshot from Twitter showing information regarding Kyle Rittenhouse and how he was charged with murder in the shooting in Wisconsin during the summer of 2020. Detective Glines found a photograph of a screenshot from Twitter that showed Stephen McDaniel, the convicted murderer in 2011, being interviewed as a part of the police investigation. The caption reads, "What a real-life psychopath looks like" and then under the photograph it reads, "Killer Stephen McDaniel keeps his body eerily still during 2-hour interrogation".

As Detective Glines continued to sort through the photographs on the iPhone Detective Glines located a screenshot of 20 mass shooters in American History with the headline stating, "Mass Shootings are a White Problem". The 20 mass shooters in the photograph are all non-white suspects.

Detective Glines located a photograph of a

. The Metadata from the photograph shows that the Camera Make is Apple, the Camera Model is iPhone SE, and the capture time is 3-24-2022 at 12:23:11 PM. Detective Glines caused a check to be made of that registration and found that the registered owner is Mark Allen Frey. There is no location data on the photograph, however the background of where the truck is parked appears to be the building.

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Detective Glines located a screenshot of a news article reading, "The FBI says a guy blew his hand off with a bomb possibly planned for an attack on 'hot cheerleaders". Also, there was a screenshot of a post from some sort of social media application speaking of a verdict of some kind of "not guilty" and "It's not violence it's self defense". Someone posted under that, "I'm going to say that when I go back to Maine with my AR-15 and light up a bunch of conservatives".

Detective Glines located two screenshots of White Page searches for "John Jacob Weiman" as well as the address . It should be noted that John Jacob Weiman is the neighbor that Joe Esquivel stated that he purchased illegal firearms from. It should also be noted that is the street behind where Joe resides in where he also made claims that someone on that street was also a part of illegal firearms purchasing.

Detective Glines sorted through the "Searched Items" from the download and found that on 5-30-2022 at 12:01 AM, Joe searched "Domestic Terrorist Law". Joe also searched numerous addresses all across the United States. Detective Glines searched some of those addresses and found that the addresses that were researched by Detective Glines returned to firearm shops.

Detective Glines sorted through the "Application Usage Log" and found that on June 9, 2022 at 2:33 PM, 2:38 PM, and 2:39 PM, Joe accessed his Apple Music Application. Detective Glines then physically looked at Joe's Apple iPhone and opened the Apple Music Application to see what the last song Joe was listening to was. Detective Glines saw that the song "Pull the Trigger" by Black Sun Empire & the State of Mind was the last song Joe listened to. Detective Glines listened to the song and found that the song is hype music with very little lyrics. The only lyrics Detective Glines could hear/understand are the words, "Sometimes you have to take matters into your own hands, Pull the Trigger".

Detective Glines also found in the "Application Usage Log" that on June 9, 2022 from 2:41 PM until 2:44 PM, Joe accessed his Bank of America application. It should be noted that Joe had received text messages from his on his Samsung device of the following:

- June 9, 2022 / 2:55:12 PM From
- June 9, 2022 / 2:55:16 PM From

Why'd u send 2000

Detective Glines believes that Joe accessed his Bank of America Application to send \$2,000

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, Ashley. Detective Glines is obtaining a subpoena for the bank account records for Joe Esquivel through Bank of America.

In reviewing the timeline for this investigation, refer to the supplemental report indicating he timeline, Detective Glines noted that that 911 call was received at 2:36 PM on June 9, 2022. This was 3 minutes after Joe accessed the Apple Music song, "Pull the Trigger". Also according to the timeline, at 2:40 PM on June 9, 2022 it was reported that Joe had fled the building in his . It should be noted that Joe accessed his Bank of America application just after fleeing from the shooting to send money to his with the anticipation of being arrested for his actions or having his life taken from him by law enforcement or himself.

Detective Glines is also having Sergeant Howard Ward from the Washington County Digital Investigation Forensic Unit review the cellular telephone downloads to verify the findings by Detective Glines.

This case is to remain closed by arrest.

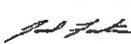
On July 12, 2022, Detective Sergeant Bryan Glines had a subpoena sent to Bank of America to receive bank records for Joe Louis Esquivel,

On July 26, 2022, Detective Glines received a response from Bank of America in regards to the subpoena. Bank of America advised that they could not provide any information that was requested. The reason was explained that they could not locate any of the accounts or records requested based on the information that was provided.

Detective Glines contacted Bank of America's legal department and inquired as to why they could not provide any information. Bank of America explained that they could not provide this information with only a name and date of birth of the customer. Bank of America stated that they need a social security number or bank account number for the customer.

Detective Glines searched Keystone, a law enforcement database, and obtained the social security number that was in that computer system. The social security number in Keystone is . On August 5, 2022, Detective Glines had a second subpoena submitted to Bank of America with the name, date of birth, and social security number that was in Keystone for Joe Esquivel.

On August 22, 2022, Detective Glines received notification from Bank of America that they again could not provide this information to Detective Glines. The reasoning was the same

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as the first subpoena that was submitted. Detective Glines contacted Bank of America again and was advised that the social security number provided was not to the name Joe Esquivel. Detective Glines asked Bank of America what name that social security number returned to and Bank of America could not provide that information. Detective Glines caused a check through CLEAR, a law enforcement computer database, for Joe Esquivel and found that Joe's social security number is

Detective Glines also retrieved the iPhone belonging to Joe Esquivel from the Washington County Sheriff's Office property. Detective Glines looked through the actual iPhone and observed the application downloaded onto the iPhone for Bank of America. Detective Glines opened the application and was able to access the Bank of America information for Joe Esquivel. Detective Glines observed two accounts for Bank of America, one being Adv Plus Banking with account number 5 with the balance of \$2,707.37 and the other Customized Cash Rewards World Mastercard Card.

Detective Glines looked at the recent transactions on the Bank of America Adv Plus Banking account and observed that on June 9, 2022 Joe made a Zelle money transfer to Ashley Esquivel for \$2,000.00. Detective Glines also observed that on June 10, 2022, a deposit was made from payroll for \$1,505.21 and another deposit from was made on June 24, 2022 for \$807.82.

Detective Glines then went to the settings on the application and observed the option to review the Login History. Detective Glines observed that there were only two log ins on June 9, 2022, one being 2:41 PM and 2:42 PM. These times coincide with the data that was located on the iPhone download of the application access as well as the text message Joe received from Ashley indicating that Joe sent her \$2,000. Therefore, after Joe Esquivel shot his co-workers, he had the mindset of getting onto his phone application while fleeing and sending nearly all of his money in his account to Ashley.

On August 23, 2022, Detective Glines had a third subpoena sent to Bank of America now with the correct social security number and bank account number for the information from the

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account.

It was also brought to Detective Glines' attention that there were rumors that Joe Esquivel had received his performance evaluation the day of the shooting and that management of brought up that Mark Frey had been complaining about Joe's performance. It was rumored that this was the cause of Joe Esquivel shooting co-worker, specifically Mark Frey, that day.

Detective Glines reached out to Tom Neil, the general manager of , and inquired as to if there was a performance evaluation that day for Joe Esquivel. Tom explained that Joe was scheduled for a performance evaluation, however it was not scheduled for June 9, 2022. Tom could not remember the date that it had been scheduled, and believes that it might have already taken place, however Tom advised that he would find the date and reach back to Detective Glines once that was obtained.

Tom also wanted to straighten out another rumor that he had heard regarding the motive for Joe Esquivel's shooting his co-workers. Tom stated that the rumor was that Joe messed up some type of part for one of the machines and that was why Joe shot his co-workers. Tom explained that Joe had not messed up any part, however Joe did set an off-set wrong on one of the machines before making the part. This wrong off-set was caught before messing up any type of part and Tom stated that the programmer corrected Joe and taught Joe what he had done wrong. Tom stated that it was not a big deal and that Joe and the programmer did not have any type of argument.

Tom Neil later contacted Detective Glines and advised that Joe Esquivel last had a performance evaluation on March 10, 2022 and that the evaluation was a satisfactory review.

This case is to remain closed, however further supplemental reports are expected.
