The Maryland Judiciary appreciates the amendments to Senate Bill 466 which alleviate many of the Judiciary's original concerns. The Judiciary, however, still has concerns with the mandatory concurrent language on page 11, lines 12 through 15. The Judiciary traditionally opposes legislation that includes mandatory provisions. The Judiciary believes it is important for judges to weigh the facts and circumstances for each individual case when imposing a sentence. Provisions that place restrictions on the judge prevent the judge from considering factors unique to the case.
