Dear Committee Members

I request an **unfavorable** vote on this bill. I have multiple reasons:

- a. The term assault represents how an object is used, not an inherent feature of the object. Hitting someone with a rock is an act of assault, but not a feature of the rock. Identifying certain firearms as "assault pistols" is therefore presumptive of how the pistol may be used.
- b. The ability to convert a firearm from semi-automatic to automatic (or even "burst") is already a Federal crime, and need not also be made a state crime.
- c. Outlawing pistols already in common use in Maryland without taking into account owners who have purchased these in the past (grandfathering) would convert law-abiding citizens into criminals.
