RE: Letter of <u>Support</u> for House Bill 238 – Public Safety – Police Accountability – Time Limit for Filing Administrative Charges

Dear Chair Clippinger, Vice-Chair Bartlett, and Members of the Judiciary Committee,

As Cecil County Executive and a retired law enforcement officer, I am writing to express my strong support for HB 238, which seeks to address investigations into police misconduct and charging dispositions taking too far long, which is unfair to both the law enforcement officer and to the public. While we should and do strive to hold our police accountable, accountability should come from both sides and it is very difficult for an officer to focus on their duties when investigations and charging decisions are dragged out, causing undue stress and resentment on both the officer and the complainant.

HB 238 rectifies this by requiring investigations and charging decisions to be completed within 366 days of the filing of a complaint by a citizen or when the employing law enforcement agency became aware of the incident. It is a fairness and efficiency issue, and this deadline is reasonable and best serves the interests of the officer, the law enforcement agency, local government, and the public.
