RE: HB0916: Criminal Law - Weapon Crimes - Transporting Firearm in Checked Bag on Public Transportation

Dear Delegates,

We oppose and respectfully request that you vote unfavorably on this bill as it is an infringement of 2<sup>nd</sup> Amendment rights.

This is another example of the State taking away the freedom of our citizens. The majority of law abiding citizens with concealed carry permits are SMART ENOUGH to unchamber a round of ammunition when placing it in an enclosed bag for transportation.
