Dear Chairperson Clippinger and Judiciary Committee,

The Frederick County State's Attorney's Office and the Maryland State's Attorney's Association support HB89 **Criminal Law - Crimes Relating to Animals - Conviction and Sentencing.** The MSAA Special Victims Committee discussed this bill and agree that these offenses should nor merge and each animal should be considered a separate victim.

Animal cruelty indicates a propensity for violence that can extend beyond animals to humans. We have reviewed hundreds of pyscho-sexual evaluations and PSIs which all show corrections between animal abuse and other forms of violent behavior, including domestic violence and sexual assault.

We ask for a favorable report of HB 89.
