

HB 0353 Public Safety - Handgun Permit Requirement - Repeal

FAVORABLE

The Maryland State Rifle & Pistol Association (MSRPA) supports repealing the requirement that a person have a certain permit before the person carries, wears, or transports a handgun, and repealing certain criminal prohibitions against a person who is at least a certain age wearing, carrying, or transporting a handgun. MSRPA also supports prohibiting the wear, carry, or transport of a handgun while under the influence of alcohol or drugs.

Self-defense is a fundamental right, and the right to use firearms for self-defense is recognized by the Constitution of the United States, the constitutions of 44 states, the laws of all states, and the common law. In District of Columbia v. Heller (2008), the Supreme Court ruled that the Second Amendment protects "the individual right to possess and carry weapons in case of confrontation."
