• 287g makes us all less safe by eroding public trust in police and scares people from being witnesses, reporting crime and cooperating in investigations

 $\cdot$  287g targets low level offenders, not those who commit violent crimes. In Frederick, since 2008, 80% of 287g detainers have been for minor Level 3 offenses, or misdemeanors, and 60% for traffic violations.

• 287g is jail based, but still has a well-documented record of rampant racial profiling by incentivizing pretextual stops to pipeline them into ICE's deportation system, eg Sara Medrano

• 287g is an unfunded mandate to local jurisdictions. Considering law enforcement's staffing shortages and challenges in recruiting -- 287g only add more to their plate, and diverts local resources and forcing local police and corrections to do ICE's job for them.
