Proposed Position on Legislation

RE: HOUSE BILL 336 Firearms- Right to Purchase, Own, Possess, and Carry

The Maryland Office of the Public Defender respectfully requests that the Committee issue a favorable report on House Bill 336.

House Bill 336 would provide medical marijuana patients with the same rights as their fellow Maryland residents. This bill would ensure that individuals do not lose their right to purchase, possess, or carry a firearm, and are thus not subject to unnecessary and potential criminalization for merely registering as a legal medical marijuana patient. Maryland already has robust laws restricting the possession of firearms. The policy purpose of those laws are not strengthened by preventing medical marijuana patients from lawfully possessing firearms. Rather, this law is in line with ongoing legislative efforts collectively aimed at decriminalizing marijuana and reducing the of individuals who may possess and use marijuana in criminal legal jeopardy.

For these reasons, the Maryland Office of the Public Defender urges this Committee to issue a favorable report on House Bill 336.
