Written Testimony for HB 403/SB 387: Correctional Services - Transfers to Federal Authorities - Undocumented Immigrants (Protecting Marylanders From Violent Offenders Act of 2025) - Please **VOTE YES** on this bill.

Dear Judiciary Committee:

This bill reads "ON REQUEST OF THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY, A STATE OR LOCAL CORRECTIONAL FACILITY WITH CUSTODY OF AN UNDOCUMENTED IMMIGRANT WHO IS SERVING A SENTENCE IN THE FACILITY FOR CONVICTION OF A CRIME SHALL TRANSFER THE INDIVIDUAL TO THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY IF THE INDIVIDUAL: (1) HAS ENGAGED IN OR IS SUSPECTED OF TERRORISM OR ESPIONAGE, OR OTHERWISE POSES A DANGER TO NATIONAL SECURITY; (2) HAS BEEN CONVICTED OF AN OFFENSE OF WHICH AN ELEMENT IS ACTIVE PARTICIPATION IN A CRIMINAL STREET GANG, AS DEFINED IN 18 U.S.C. § 6 521; (3) IS AT LEAST 16 YEARS OLD AND INTENTIONALLY PARTICIPATED IN A CRIMINAL STREET GANG, AS DEFINED IN 18 U.S.C. § 521, TO FURTHER ILLEGAL ACTIVITIES; OR (4) HAS BEEN CONVICTED OF AN AGGRAVATED FELONY, AS DEFINED 11 IN 8 U.S.C. § 1101..."

This is a common sense bill that will keep our country and our citizens safe. It only stipulates transfer of an undocumented illegal immigrant to Homeland Security UPON REQUEST of Homeland Security and only IF the individual is SERVING A SENTENCE for a CONVICTION of a crime that relates to TERRORISM OR ESPIONAGE, "or otherwise poses a danger to national security", ACTIVE GANG PARTICIPATION AND ACTIVITY, or AGGRAVATED FELONIES. This makes perfect sense, and I am extremely happy to see a common sense bill that addresses violent illegal immigrant criminal offenders! I applaud all the sponsors of this bill for coming together in order to pass common sense legislation that will keep Maryland and its citizens safer!
