I support HB0365 because, like many Marylanders, I have made mistakes and have had encounters with the criminal justice system. I am still affected by a wrongful conviction. Although lawmakers passed a bill in 2021 called the Walter Lomax Act, which aims to restore justice for the wrongly accused, I had to represent myself pro se because there were no attorneys familiar with the law who would take on my case.

1. Who will enforce these laws? Will there be attorneys available, and will there be fee waivers for court costs?
2. Who will be responsible for handling requests related to violations of these new laws?
3. Who can and cannot have disclosure?
4. How will anybody know if someone, an employer, etc, is seeking more information?
