- Requiring, on or before January 1 each year, each county board of education to provide certain information to the parents or legal guardians of students who attend a failing school;
- requiring that a failing school continue to be designated as a failing school until certain conditions are met;
- requiring that a student who is attending a failing school be provided the opportunity to attend an alternative school;
- establishing the Broadening Options and Opportunities for Students Today Program.
