RE: Support for House Bill 1042 – Enhancing Transparency and Integrity in Mail In Ballot Voting

Dear Chair Atterbeary, Vice Chair Wilkins, and Esteemed Members of the Committee,

I am writing to express my strong support for House Bill 1042, an essential measure aimed at reinforcing transparency and integrity in Maryland's mail in voting process.
