

Moms for Liberty Maryland Legislative Committee respectfully requests an Unfavorable Report for HB 0197, cross filed with SB 0068: Public Schools - Restorative Practices Schools - Comprehensive Plan.

There is not a one size fits all discipline solution for every school district. We are witnessing a crisis of safety in our classrooms that is only being exacerbated by the ideological adherence to Restorative Justice Practices. Schools must be able to determine the discipline policies that work and should not be forced to accept a flawed political agenda as the basis for their discipline policy.

The concern for repeat offenders should not trump all the other students in the classroom. We must be considerate of the safety of all the students, teachers and staff. All students deserve to have a safe learning environment. A majority of nearly every demographic group backs strict laws to best assist our juvenile offenders ultimately realize at least a chance at a successful, happy life."
