Re: HB949 – Calvert County - Payment in Lieu of Taxes Agreements - Qualified Data Centers

Chair Atterbeary, Vice Chair Wilkins, and Committee Members:

The Board of County Commissioners for Calvert County writes in **SUPPORT** of **HB949** and requests a **FAVORABLE** Committee report. This Bill is enabling legislation that allows the local government, and its citizens, to contemplate a Payment of Lieu of Tax ("PILOT") for cloud computing centers. A PILOT program ensures negotiated payments are made to the local government; instead of a bill for local taxes, the taxpayer receives an invoice for the negotiated payment due. These agreements ease budgeting for public services, such as schools, roads, and emergency services, because revenues are predictable; additionally, there will be no appeals of assessment. In short, a PILOT agreement provides a clear, and mutually agreed-upon, financial arrangement.

PILOT agreements are also a tool to attract the significant infrastructure and investment these cloud computing centers require. Hosting a cloud computing center leads to job creation (both direct and indirect) and economic growth in the region. A PILOT agreement also affords an opportunity to mitigate any less attractive aspects of this land use. By way of example, a PILOT for a cloud computing center can be structured to balance the interests of both the local government and the company. A PILOT can create incentives:

- For using green energy to power the facility;
- Ensuring responsible water usage, including the use of reclaimed grey water; and
- For infrastructure development and sustainability programs.
