



Moms for Liberty Maryland Legislative Committee supports HB 0137, Public Schools – Children Charged With a Crime of Violence – Prohibition on In-Person Attendance (School Safety Act of 2025)

School safety is paramount to the delivery of a quality public school education. We are witnessing a crisis in school safety in Maryland public schools.

The loopholes inherent in current state law have led to death. Moms for Liberty Maryland Legislative Committee demands action from the Maryland General

Assembly to prevent any more senseless deaths in our public schools.

Every public school system in Maryland needs to have open and effective communication with both the Department of Juvenile Services (DJS) and local law enforcement. Superintendents must be notified when any juvenile suspected of a violent reportable offense such as rape, assault or murder is enrolled in one of their schools.

Moms for Liberty Maryland Legislative Committee requests a favorable report for HB 0137. If a student in a Maryland public school has been identified by law enforcement as a suspect in a crime of violence, that student should be prohibited from in-person attendance in any public school until the investigation is complete and the student is no longer identified as a suspect. This is common sense.
