I strongly oppose HB0875 for the following reasons.

- 1. **State Autonomy**: The creation of a state commission to oversee educational content is an overreach into local education systems. I prefer local control over education. I believe such decisions should be made at local BOE.
- 2. **Lack of Resource**: Establishing and maintaining a new commission requires funding and administrative resources. Maryland already suffered 2.7 Billion deficit. We don't have the money for such commission.
- 3. **Political Influence**: I don't want the Democratic Party to advance the dangerous progressive political agendas under the guise of education reform, potentially leading to the politicization of school curricula.
