House Ways and Means Committee House Economic Matters Committee March 6, 2025 House Bill 1469 – Taxes – Sugary Beverage Distributor Tax (For Our Kids Act) **POSITION: SUPPORT**

The Maryland State Medical Society (MedChi), the largest physician organization in Maryland, supports House Bill 1469, which aims to improve public health outcomes by addressing the consumption of sugar-laden beverages and unhealthy dietary habits that contribute to chronic disease.
