My name is Patti Smith and I am a childcare provider from Greenbelt Maryland. I am here today to firmly express my strong support for the For Our Kids Act (House Bill 1469), which will promote healthier choices for Maryland's children and support working families by increasing access to nutritious school meals and affordable childcare through a sugary drink tax.

The bill will also provide much-needed funding for childcare scholarships, making quality care more affordable and accessible for working families.
