**RE: FAVORABLE - SUPPORT of House Bill 1455
State Retirement and Pension System - Divestment From Israel**

To the Chair Barnes, Vice Chair Kaiser, and esteemed members of the Appropriations Committee,

My name is Eric Musa, I am a resident of Frederick, MD, District 3. I am writing to name my support for HB 1455 the "State Retirement and Pension System - Divestment From Israel" bill. This bill would require Maryland's State Retirement and Pension System (MSRPS) to review and divest, where possible, from existing investments in the State of Israel, and prevent new funds from being invested.

How we invest our money matters. It sets a standard and expectation of our future. They reflect the values and priorities of a society, showing how resources are allocated to support various needs, especially for vulnerable populations. Our pension system's public commitments to socially responsible investing and obligations as a signatory of the United Nations Principles for Responsible Investment demand we address our existing \$73.7 million of investments in Israeli bonds by MSRPS (as of July 30, 2025) whose State is accused of committing War Crimes. If Maryland claims a commitment to socially responsible investing, our pension funds cannot be used to financially support a government whose actions raise serious human rights concerns.

If the decision to safeguard peoples' futures without causing or supporting the suffering of others cannot be made, then we as a society have failed. Every pensioner is unknowingly complicit in the atrocities their benefits are invested in. Each step we take to divest from war and war crimes is a step in the right direction.

For these reasons and many more, **I ask the Appropriations Committee to give HB 1455 a favorable report.**
