Dear Chair Delegate Barnes, Vice Chair Delegate Kaiser and members of the Committee:

I write in strong support of HB 1592 which extends the per capita increases for the county libraries and regional resource centers through FY32.

This continued funding will support small and rural libraries through State Aid and the Regional Resource Centers. Oftentimes, these libraries are the first to experience economic downturns while helping the communities most in need of library service. As living expenses continue to rise, libraries provide free access to books and materials, programs for all ages, the internet, and other technology, including laptops and Wi-Fi hotspots. We help people find employment and provide space for Marylanders to easily access services such as tax assistance, veteran benefits, and health insurance information.

Worcester County Library is fortunate to be a member of the Eastern Shore Regional Library (ESRL).
