RE: Senate Bill 690 - *Property and Casualty Insurance - Distribution of Premium Tax Proceeds to State Disaster Recovery Fund*

UNFAVORABLE

Dear Chairman Guzzone and Members of the Committee,

On behalf of the Maryland Association of Mutual Insurance Companies (MAMIC), we respectfully oppose Senate Bill 690.

As you may recall, MAMIC is comprised of 12 mutual insurance companies that are headquartered in Maryland and neighboring states. Approximately one-half of our members are domiciled in Maryland, and are key contributors and employers in our local communities. Together, MAMIC members offer a wide variety of insurance products and services and provide coverage for thousands of Maryland citizens.

MAMIC notes that insurance premium tax proceeds paid to the State are already committed to existing State budget items, including the operational costs of the Maryland Insurance Administration. While we do not object to the sponsor's desire to secure adequate funding for disaster relief, and we acknowledge the need for such relief from time to time, we do not believe that shifting funds from this revenue source is appropriate for this purpose.

For these reasons, MAMIC respectfully requests an unfavorable report on Senate Bill 690.
