As the former owner of two casinos, I am writing today in opposition to legalizing iGaming.

Maryland's brick-and-mortar casinos are a cornerstone of the State's economy, driving substantial revenues to Maryland and its local communities. I know firsthand, that the casinos spent over \$3 billion in initial construction and another \$1 billion since opening. In addition, Maryland's "in person" casino gaming supports over 15,000 jobs.

I am very concerned that the introduction of iGaming would cannibalize our brick-and-mortar casinos which would adversely impact the casinos and the casino employees. I am also very worried that iGaming would fuel gambling addictions, since everyone would be able to gamble at any time, day or night, 24/7 on their smart phones or at home on their computers.

I hope that you and your committee members will reject both SB 761 & SB 885.
