Senate Bill 869 (SB 869) establishes the Maryland Workforce Launch Pilot Program within the Department of Commerce to provide customized, no-cost workforce training in partnership with community colleges as a tool to attract and grow strategic industries in the State.

Maryland's ability to compete for new investment and job creation increasingly depends on the strength and responsiveness of its workforce pipeline. By aligning workforce training with the needs of targeted industries and offering tailored training solutions to prospective employers, this program would position Maryland more competitively when recruiting businesses considering relocation or expansion.

The Maryland Workforce Launch Pilot Program represents a strategic approach to workforce development by leveraging the expertise of the State's community colleges and coordinating efforts through the Department of Commerce. Programs like this can help close skills gaps, support business growth, and ensure Maryland workers are prepared for in-demand careers.
