Support for SB 50

To the members of the Senate Education, Energy, and Environment Committee:

As a Maryland citizen who was raised in Maryland and fathered a strong family that has produced several grand children who are also being raised here in Maryland, I strongly support Senate Bill 50, the Fairness in Girls' Sports Act, and ask for a favorable report on this important legislation to protect female high school athletes.

SB 50 makes perfectly reasonable and rational sense permitting only girls who are embracing the sex in which they were born, with no physical or medical modification, to participate in school team sports. This bill enables girls to do so without being adversely impacted by having to compete with others who were not born as females and who on average have materially more strength and and greater body mass than girls do on average.

This legislation does nothing more than to provide continuity of fair and meaningful competition on the field of play for female athletes.

It is time for Maryland to pass legislation protecting female athletes the same way 27 other states have done so.
