Dear Chair Feldman, Vice Chair Kagan, and Distinguished Members of the Senate Education, Energy, and the Environment Committee,

For the record, I am Delegate Ryan Nawrocki, requesting a favorable report on HB 89 – Maryland Office of the Inspector General for Education - Baltimore County Public Schools - Memorandum of Understanding.

As amended, this bill directs the Maryland Office of the Inspector General for Education and the Baltimore County Inspector General to pursue a formal memorandum of understanding on matters pertaining to the school system. The bill does not mandate a final agreement but encourages a good-faith effort to establish a clear, structured framework for collaboration.

In recent years, the respective officeholders informally maintained such an agreement, and both offices found it to be highly effective in clarifying roles, reducing duplication, and improving the efficiency of investigations and oversight. However, because that understanding was tied to individuals rather than institutionalized between the offices themselves, it is no longer in effect. By encouraging these offices to formalize future collaboration, HB 89 would ensure that the benefits of coordination are preserved regardless of personnel changes.

This amended bill is the product of many long hours of discussion and collaboration with the members of the Baltimore County House Delegation. I am thankful for the members from both parties representing all parts of Baltimore County who came together to offer meaningful feedback and distinct perspectives, ultimately helping revise this bill to the point where it passed unanimously out of the delegation.

This is a simple and common-sense measure that supports transparency, accountability, and responsible governance in one of Maryland's largest school systems. Therefore, I respectfully ask the committee for a **favorable report for HB 89**.
