AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 1522

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 2, strike “**and**” and substitute a comma; in the same line, after the second “**Monitoring**” insert “, **and Work Zone Speed Control**”; in line 7, strike “or” and substitute a comma; in the same line, after the second “system” insert “, **or a work zone speed control system**”; in line 8, strike “and” and substitute a comma; in line 9, after “monitoring” insert “, **and work zone speed control**”; in line 12, strike the third “and” and substitute a comma; in the same line, after “(b)(1)(i)” insert “, **and 21–810(a)(1) and (7), (b)(1), and (c)(1)**”; in line 17, strike “and” and substitute a comma; and in the same line, after “21–809(a)(4)” insert “, **and 21–810(a)(3)**”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 3, after line 3, insert:

“21–810.

(a) (1) In this section the following words have the meanings indicated.

(3) [(i)] “Owner” means the registered owner of a motor vehicle or a lessee of a motor vehicle [under a lease of 6 months or longer].

[(ii)] “Owner” does not include:

1. A motor vehicle rental or leasing company; or

2. A holder of a special registration plate issued under Title 13, Subtitle 9, Part III of this article.]

(7) “Work zone speed control system” means a device that:

(i) Has one or more motor vehicle sensors connected to a camera system capable of producing recorded images of motor vehicles traveling at or above a predetermined speed in or approaching a work zone; and

(ii) Is equipped with flashing blue lights.

(b) (1) A work zone speed control system that meets the requirements of this subsection may be used to record the images of motor vehicles traveling on a highway:

(i) Within a work zone; and

(ii) On which the speed limit, as posted before the work zone was implemented and established using generally accepted traffic engineering practices, is 45 miles per hour or greater.

(c) (1) Unless the driver of the motor vehicle received a citation from a police officer at the time of the violation, the owner or, in accordance with subsection (f)(4) of this section, the driver of a motor vehicle is subject to a civil penalty if an image of the motor vehicle is recorded by a work zone speed control system in accordance with subsection (b) of this section while being operated in violation of this subtitle.”.
