The Maryland Department of Veterans and Military Families (DVMF) is committed to leading veterans and their families through life's transitions, making Maryland the best state for military-connected communities. Our department supports Senate Bill 199 - Individuals With Disabilities and Service-Disabled Veterans Boating Fund - Eligible Companions.

In 2024, DVMF was proud to support the creation of the Individuals with Disabilities and Service-Disabled Veterans Boating Fund. This year, SB199 expands the fund's purpose to include an eligible companion, meaning an accompanying family member or direct support professional of an individual with disabilities or of a service-disabled veteran participating in sailing, boating, kayaking, canoeing, paddleboarding, or surfing activities.

Including eligible companions in the fund's purpose shows Maryland's commitment to understanding the day-to-day realities of living with a disability, and reinforces Governor Moore's pledge to leave no one behind. This bill has no fiscal impact.
