A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Public Utilities – For–Hire Drivers and Transportation Network Operators –**
3 **Human Trafficking Awareness and Prevention Training and Liability**

4 FOR the purpose of requiring an applicant for certain for–hire driver’s licenses ~~and~~
5 ~~transportation network operator’s licenses~~ to submit to the Public Service
6 Commission documentation verifying that the applicant completed a certain human
7 trafficking awareness training program; prohibiting licensed taxicab drivers,
8 for–hire drivers, or transportation network operators and applicants for a transportation
9 network operator’s license from being held civilly or
10 criminally liable for reporting or responding to in good faith a suspected incident of
11 human trafficking; prohibiting a transportation network company from allowing certain
applicants for and holders of a transportation network operator’s license to provide
transportation network services using a digital network application if the applicant or
license holder has not completed a certain human trafficking awareness training program;
and generally relating to for–hire drivers and transportation
network operators.

(g) (1) THIS SUBSECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO AN INDIVIDUAL WHO:

(i) SUBMITTED AN APPLICATION FOR A TRANSPORTATION NETWORK
OPERATOR'S LICENSE ON OR BEFORE SEPTEMBER 30, 2026; AND

(ii) COMPLETED, BETWEEN JUNE 1, 2025, AND NOVEMBER 30, 2026, A
HUMAN TRAFFICKING AWARENESS TRAINING THAT MEETS THE REQUIREMENTS OF PARAGRAPHS (2)
AND (3) OF THIS SUBSECTION.

(2) A TRANSPORTATION NETWORK COMPANY MAY NOT ALLOW AN APPLICANT FOR A
TRANSPORTATION NETWORK OPERATOR'S LICENSE OR THE HOLDER OF A TEMPORARY OR PERMANENT
TRANSPORTATION NETWORK OPERATOR'S LICENSE TO PROVIDE TRANSPORTATION NETWORK SERVICES
USING A DIGITAL NETWORK APPLICATION UNLESS THE APPLICANT OR LICENSE HOLDER, WITHIN
30 DAYS AFTER THE APPLICANT OR LICENSE HOLDER FIRST PROVIDES A PREARRANGED RIDE, HAS
COMPLETED:

(i) THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION'S LEADERS AGAINST HUMAN
TRAFFICKING/COMBATTING HUMAN TRAFFICKING IN THE TRANSPORTATION AWARENESS TRAINING;

(ii) ANY NATIONALLY RECOGNIZED HUMAN TRAFFICKING AWARENESS
TRAINING PROGRAM; OR

(iii) ANY DIGITAL TRAINING DEVELOPED BY A TRANSPORTATION NETWORK
COMPANY IN CONSULTATION WITH A NATIONALLY RECOGNIZED ORGANIZATION WITH EXPERTISE IN
HUMAN TRAFFICKING AWARENESS TRAINING.

(3) A HUMAN TRAFFICKING AWARENESS TRAINING THAT AN APPLICANT OR
LICENSE HOLDER COMPLETES UNDER PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION MUST INCLUDE
INFORMATION ON HOW TO:

(i) RECOGNIZE POTENTIAL VICTIMS OF HUMAN TRAFFICKING;

(ii) RESPOND TO AN INDIVIDUAL WHO MAY BE OR IS A VICTIM OF HUMAN
TRAFFICKING; AND

(iii) REPORT SUSPECTED INCIDENTS OF HUMAN TRAFFICKING TO
APPROPRIATE AUTHORITIES.

(4) AN APPLICANT FOR A TRANSPORTATION NETWORK OPERATOR'S LICENSE OR
THE HOLDER OF A TEMPORARY OR PERMANENT TRANSPORTATION NETWORK OPERATOR'S LICENSE MAY
NOT BE HELD CIVILLY OR CRIMINALLY LIABLE FOR REPORTING OR RESPONDING IN GOOD FAITH
TO A SUSPECTED INCIDENT OF HUMAN TRAFFICKING.
