ALL PICTURES ARE OF THE “RESTORED” STREAM. THE STREAM REMAINS BIOLOGICALLY IMPAIRED TODAY, IN YEAR 6 OF THE RESTORATION.

THE STREAM NEVER LEFT ITS BANKS PRIOR TO THE RESTORATION. THE DARK, MOIST, FOREST HAD LEAF LITTER, RICH SOIL, AND WAS HOME TO MANY NATIVE WOODLAND AND WETLAND SPECIES. THE CREEK FILLED WITH SEDIMENT AND THE STREAM CORRIDOR IS FILLED WITH INVASIVE SPECIES.
