SB797: Maryland Medical Assistance Program and Health Insurance— Claims for Reimbursement – Downcoding

Position: Support with amendments

Dear Chair, Vice Chair, and Members of the Committee:

On behalf of the Maryland Podiatric Medical Association (MPMA), representing over 230 podiatrists licensed in Maryland and the practice of podiatry, I write to support SB 797 with amendments. We request provider specific language.

On page 5, lines 4, delete the term “physician” and insert “licensed health care provider”.

On page 5, delete lines 5 and 6, and insert “(1) licensed by the same Board as the treating provider; and”

These amendments require a similarly licensed health care providers to make a final decision regarding services provided within the provider’s scope and knowledge. This decision should not be limited to physicians.
