**RE:** SB 385 Public Health - Recommendations for Immunizations, Screenings, and Preventative Services - Pharmacist Administration and Required Health Insurance Coverage (The Vax Act)

Dear Chairperson Beidle, Vice Chairperson Hayes and Members of the Committee:

The Board of Pharmacy (the “Board”) worked closely with the Maryland Department of Health last fall to ensure all Marylanders had access to certain vaccines. The Board feels that HB 637 is a continuation of the Department’s efforts to provide access to vaccinations based on sound clinical guidance and therefore, the Board is in full support. In addition, HB 637 provides much needed clarity for pharmacists who provide vaccination services to a significant number of Maryland citizens. Since the COVID pandemic, the State has increasingly relied on pharmacists to provide immunizations to the citizens of Maryland. This bill would ensure the ability of pharmacists to continue to provide these vital services without risk or ambiguity that may arise from possible CDC deviations from prevailing clinical guidelines.

To that end, the Board of Pharmacy requests that you return a favorable report.
