**House Bill 1010 - Election Law - Certification of Election-Supporting Technology - Regulations,
Review, and Evaluation - FAVORABLE**

Dear Government, Labor, and Elections Committee Members:

As a Maryland citizen I urge your support for HB 1010, *Election Law - Certification of Election-Supporting Technology - Regulations, Review, and Evaluation*.

We need ranked choice voting to be an option across Maryland.

The benefits of ranked choice voting are proven and clear at the local and state level. I support ranked choice voting as an essential democracy reform forward for the county.

We've seen RCV in Alaska, Maine and NYC stimulate more participation in voters and more collaboration among candidates, both better for the country.

Therefore, the State Board of Elections should adopt regulations for the review, certification, and decertification of election-supporting technology and to review and evaluate election-supporting technology on or before January 1 each year; and requiring that the regulations be adopted by December 1, 2026.

I urge the Government, Labor, and Elections Committee to give HB 1010 full consideration and a favorable report.
