
We support SB 848 with the following amendment to ensure tabulation procedures for municipalities that have adopted or use ranked choice voting are available to the public and reviewed by the State Board of Elections for compliance.

Proposed Amendment:

ANY MUNICIPALITY THAT CONDUCTS ELECTIONS USING RANKED-CHOICE VOTING
SHALL PROVIDE REGULATIONS ON THE TABULATION OF RANKED BALLOTS TO THE
STATE BOARD FOR REVIEW AND APPROVAL FOR USE WITH STATE VOTING EQUIPMENT.

We urge the Committee to include this amendment and appreciate the work of the bill sponsors to bring more transparency and awareness to municipal elections.
