What the Bill Does:

The purpose of HB522: Anne Arundel County – Alcoholic Beverages Licenses – Class Per Diem – License Fees – Altering the license fee structure for Class C per diem beer, beer and wine, and beer, wine, and liquor licenses issued by the Board of License Commissioners for Anne Arundel County.

Why the Bill is Important:

HB522 establishes that events with an estimated attendance of five hundred or more individuals fees will be based on the cost per point-of-sale location that serves alcohol at the event per day. This structure ensures that larger events with multiple service points pay fees proportional to their alcohol sales operation.
