Baltimore County **SUPPORTS only as Amended** Senate Bill 114. The County has been supportive of expanding 311 Nonemergency Systems across the state to combat high volume nonemergency call times and ensure constituent needs and services are met.

The County initially had concerns regarding the structure of the bill as introduced as it could have negatively impacted the operations of Baltimore County’s 311 System. However, the County along with several over jurisdictions with 311 systems worked with the sponsor to address our collective concerns. Senate Bill 114 as amended in the Senate, reflects our negotiated amendments.
