AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 361
(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

In line 4, strike "purpose" and substitute "purposes"; and in line 5, after "completing" insert "a transfer of ownership and renewal and completing".

AMENDMENT NO. 2

In line 8, strike ", notwithstanding § 12-2202 of the Alcoholic Beverages and Cannabis Article,"; and in line 10, strike "2029," and substitute "2029."

(1) notwithstanding § 12-1705 of the Alcoholic Beverages and Cannabis Article for the purposes of completing a transfer of ownership and renewal at the same location; and

(2) notwithstanding § 12-2202 of the Alcoholic Beverages and Cannabis Article."
