RE: HB181

Position: Oppose without Amendments

This bill as written would put an undue burden on small food facilities.

This bill should apply only to food service facilities that are also subject to the federal menu labeling law/regulations, which applies to restaurants and similar retail food establishments selling restaurant-type food that are part of a chain with 20 or more fixed locations; doing business under the same name; and offering for sale substantially the same menu items. Same as California Law [SB 68](#).

Liability protection language for facilities that would be subject to such a new food allergen disclosure law.
