

Testimony of Seth B. Miller
On OHCQ Advisory Committee

Madam Chair and committee thank
you for your service.

If I am to be arrested, please bring a wheelchair and cuff me from the front. I am disabled.

In the United States, dignity and decorum of government exist not to elevate governing over governed, but to remind officeholders of an oath of office.

This bill is a Band-Aid remedy.

As a short term recovery patient at Potomac Valley Nursing and Rehab, I saw my friend and former roommate attacked twice. First by a third roommate. Next by staff. It could have been me. I do not remember anything from the accident whereby I went from paralegal to patient. I remember vividly John beating Brian.

I made the nurse called police under threat of reporting her to the state. police report attached.

No Police Report for second attack.

OHCQ did nothing. Covid came. Potomac Valley had known Covid positives. They chose not to isolate known positives. They chose to accept known negatives. Of those accepted negative, 10 contracted Covid. Five died per the Washington Post. Had OHCQ listened when I complained about the attacks on Brian staff would've

gotten it together in those five would be alive.

I asked for and received legislation on increased inpatient phone access. Thank you Senator Salling and Delegate Woorman. I know neither of you support my testimony. MDH came out against phones and cameras. MDH came up with a fairytale that increased phone access would jeopardize CMS accreditation. The architect of that theory is no longer with MDH.

OHCQ faces a class action for failure to conduct site surveys. Correspondence from OHCQ included shows they don't care. How many MDH officials left due to failed record?

The General Assembly telling OHCQ to shape up reminds me of my mother telling me not to pick on my brother.

I call on CMS to take over site survey function from OHCQ.

I call on Governor Moore to support bones and cameras.
