Bill:	Senate Bill 626 – Sex Designation on Certificates of Birth, Licenses, and Identification Cards and Birth Information Histories (Birth Certificate Modernization Act)

The Maryland Affiliate of the American College of Nurse Midwives (ACNM) supports *Senate Bill 626 – Sex Designation on Certificates of Birth, Licenses, and Identification Cards, and Birth Information Histories (Birth Certificate Modernization Act)*. The bill allows the Maryland Secretary of Health to issue a new birth certificate with a sex designation of female, male, or unspecified or another. The new birth certificate cannot show any markings that it was changed. The legislation also removes the requirement that a healthcare provider attests to an individual having undergone treatment for transition.

ACNM supports recognizing the spectrum of gender identities, which include non-binary identities.ⁱ Marylanders should not be forced to choose a binary option on their birth certificates. People should also not have to undergo treatment, including full transition care, to modify a birth certificate that reflects their identity.

Transgender individuals face hostile environment with increasing attacks on their wellbeing and safety.ⁱⁱ This legislation helps mitigate safety risks by their birth certificates match their identities.
